Let me review some of the main developments since last year's meeting:

Concerning Partnership ADB- AFD :

- This strategic partnership that started in 1997 resulting in co-financing over 30 projects and amounting to over \$30 billion. It has demonstrated to be both well structured, and adaptable to the changing needs of our partner countries;
- Our PPTA trust-fund has been refilled;
- Next annual meeting in Baku could be the opportunity to highlight new co-financed projects

Concerning AFD's Strategy :

- Adoption of a new Strategy for Asia 2013-2016. Our mandate for Asia is focused on "green and inclusive growth" with differenciated partnerships and support of French expertise.
- 70 % of projects financed by the AFD must encompass a co-benefit on climate in the wake of COP 21.

Concerning our country operations:

- Discussions concerning the transport sector in Kazakhstan and Azerbaijan
- Preparation of a project concerning solid Waste Management in Uzbekistan
- Focus on the hydropower sector in Pakistan
- Focus on agriculture and health in Afghanistan

- Focus on biodiversity, energy and water in China
- Prospection in Mongolia

I am convinced that our participation in this ministerial conference will give an opportunity to strengthen relations with the governments and other donors active in the region.
