CCC Priority Areas

- ❑ Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Procedures and Documentation
 - Status of accession to Revised Kyoto Convention

 - Ensure interconnectivity of NSWs
 - Proposal for a regional information exchange platform
 - Private sector role in SW development
