Overview

- Customs cooperation core of the CAREC trade facilitation program.
- CCC's 5 Priority Areas:
 - Simplification and harmonization of Customs procedures and documentation;
 - Risk management and post-entry audit;
 - ICT for Customs modernization and data exchange;
 - ☐ Joint customs control (JCC); and
 - Regional transit.

Key Issues

- Lack of a more focused and coordinated approach to harmonize Customs related measures and procedures with international best practices.
- Ascension of the 5 remaining countries to RKC by 2015 → align national legislation of CAREC countries with the RKC.
- Integrating and upgrading risk management systems and techniques.
- Lack of a regional information exchange mechanism to promote real-time collaboration.

The Proposed Regional Technical Assistance

The proposed TA will support 3 of the 5 CCC priority areas:

- Simplification and harmonization of Customs procedures and documentation
- ii. ICT for Customs modernization and data exchange
- iii. Risk management and post-entry audit

OVERALL OBJECTIVE: Promote a harmonized approach to customs reforms by applying international best practices.

PROJECT COMPONENTS AND KEY ACTIVITIES

Simplification and harmonization of procedures

- > Capacity building workshops and training on RKC compliance.
- > Review of legislative measures and align with best practices.
- ➤ Gap analysis to identify legislative and procedural reform.
- >Support in drafting an accession action plan.

Strengthen Risk

Management Systems

- ➤ Workshops on the WCO Risk Management Compendium.
- > Review and assess risk management practices.
- Develop recommendations to upgrade risk management systems.
- ➤Introduce the AEO Program (select pilot countries, initially).
- >Stakeholder consultations on the AEO program.


Use of ICT Applications

- Review of ICT systems of CAREC Customs administrations
- >Assess feasibility of a regional information exchange mechanism for CAREC Customs.
- Develop a framework for a regional electronic information exchange for CAREC.
- ➤ Pilot test the framework in 2 countries.


Linking TA Outputs to CCC's Priority Areas of Work




Risk management and Post-Entry Audit
