## **Customs Transit Regime**



- Customs Transit Regime: Heart of a Transit System
- The efficiency of the corridor supply chain depends on the design of the customs transit regime and above all on its implementation

## **Core Transit Principles**

- Customs should ensure cargoes are secure by sealing vehicles.
- Principal of the transit operation should deposit a guarantee based on fiscal risk.
- Regulation of transit operators from a Customs and transport perspective.
- Customs should properly manage and verify information on goods in transit.

### **Transit Arrangements in the Region**

### Bilateral/Regional Agreements

### National Transit Regimes

- limited to national territory due to lack of chain guarantee systems.
- TIR
  - provides a single procedure from the point of departure to destination

### Key Issues

### Lack of regional cooperation

- Mutual recognition of customs controls and procedures, seals and stamps
- Inadequate regional guarantee system
- Transport/Transit agreements lack customs transit components
- Weaknesses in Information Systems and Guarantee Management
- Quality of transport services

## **PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

- Identify options for establishing an effective and affordable Customs transit regime for the CAREC corridors (corridor-based transit regime).
- Examine the feasibility of implementing a pilot Customs transit regime.

### **PROJECT OUTPUTS AND ACTIVITIES**

OUTPUT 1: Establish a guarantee mechanism	<ul> <li>Consultations between relevant stakeholders; banks, insurance companies, transporters, customs</li> <li>Assess feasibility to extend national guarantees across borders</li> <li>Review and assess the potential for a corridor-based Customs transit regime</li> <li>Develop an implementation plan to pilot test regional Customs</li> </ul>
	transit (along 1 CAREC corridor)
OUTPUT 2: Streamline legal & regulatory framework	<ul> <li>Legislative evaluation of the compatibility between national transit legislations</li> <li>Prepare a set of draft requirements for a regional transit system</li> </ul>

OUTPUT 3: Advice on ICT Systems Development

• Review current use of ICT in transit operations

• Develop system requirements and operational scope of an ICT system to support a regional transit regime
