Points of Discussion

- (2) The public sector's potential role to improve and beef up CPMM data
 - CPMM only have sample data provided by the private sector
 - Include Customs' statistics side by side CPMM estimates
- (3) Improved access to rail data
 - Some CFCFA partner associations cannot gather other useful information without the assistance from the government
