RIGHTS & OBLIGATIONS OF CONTRACTING PARTIES TO RKC

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

ARTICLE 2 OF BODY

 Contracting Parties (CPs) have the right to apply all prohibitions and restrictions deriving from their national legislation

GENERAL PRINCIPLES (ctd)

ARTICLE 3 OF BODY

 CPs SHALL give a general undertaking to apply the Standards, Transitional Standards (TS) and Recommended Practices (RP) set out in the Annexes/Chapters

Acceptance provisions and reservations

- Article 12 provides
 - for the obligatory acceptance of all the provisions in the GA
- CPs are nevertheless free to accept only a limited number of Specific Annexes(SA) as well as Chapters therein

Acceptance provisions and reservations (ctd)

- CPs which accept a SA or Chapter(s) therein shall be bound by all the Standards and Recommended Practices (RP) therein, unless it notifies the depository of the RPs in respect of which it enters reservations.
- Any CP which has entered reservations may withdraw them at any time by notification to the depository specifying the date on which such withdrawal takes effect

Acceptance of the provisions and reservations (ctd)

- Each CP bound by a SA or Chapter(s) therein shall
 - review the reservations every 3 YEARS
 - Inform the depository if reservations are to be continued
 - specify the provisions of its national legislation which, in its opinion, are contrary to the withdrawal of the reservations.

Implementation of the provisions

- Article 13 provides for transitional period to be granted to CPs to apply the Standards, TS and RPs
- CPs may request the Management Committee, before the end of the relevant period
 - to provide an extension to implement the provisions of the General Annex
 - And state the reasons for such request

Management of the Convention

- Article 6 provides for CPs to
 - be members of the Management Committee
 - have the right to vote

- Observers may
 - attend the meeting
 - and participate in discussions
 - but have no right to vote

Management of the Convention (ctd)

- Management Committee shall
 - meet at least once each year
 - and annually elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman
 - Secure uniformity in the implementation and application
 - Consider amendments to the Convention
 - Review and upgrade guidelines
 - Settle Disputes (after bilateral negotiations)

Amendments to the Convention

- Article 15 provides for amendments to the Body of this Convention and to the GA, the SA as well as for the incorporation of new Chapters in the GA.
- New SAs and new Chapters in SAs are recommended to the CPs under the provisions of Article 6 but enter into force under the provisions of Article 18

Set of notifications

 A number of the provisions of the Convention require the CPs to communicate specified information to the Secretary General of the Council.
