







CAREC Integrated Trade Facilitation Program Goals



- Reduce transaction costs and time by
 - improving administrative efficiency
 - simplifying, standardizing, and harmonizing trade procedures.
- Encourage the free movement of people and goods.
- Increase the transparency of trade regulations and procedures.

Customs Cooperation

- Information and communication technology for customs modernization and data exchange
- Risk management and post-entry audit

- Capacity building



CPMM: Measuring Performance Border crossing duration, Road Transport, 2011



CPMM: Identifying Constraints and Measures for Improvement



- CAREC CPMM demonstrates clearly that:
 - Border crossing points are THE bottleneck;
 - Trade logistics services are inadequate;
 - Customs clearance is one of the principal causes of delays in completing border formalities....and extorting unofficial payments;
 - There is a need for concerted efforts by other border control agencies.
- Remedial measures being taken include:
 - Developing single window and improving border crossing points
 - Time release study and coordinated border management
 - Promoting SPS cooperation
