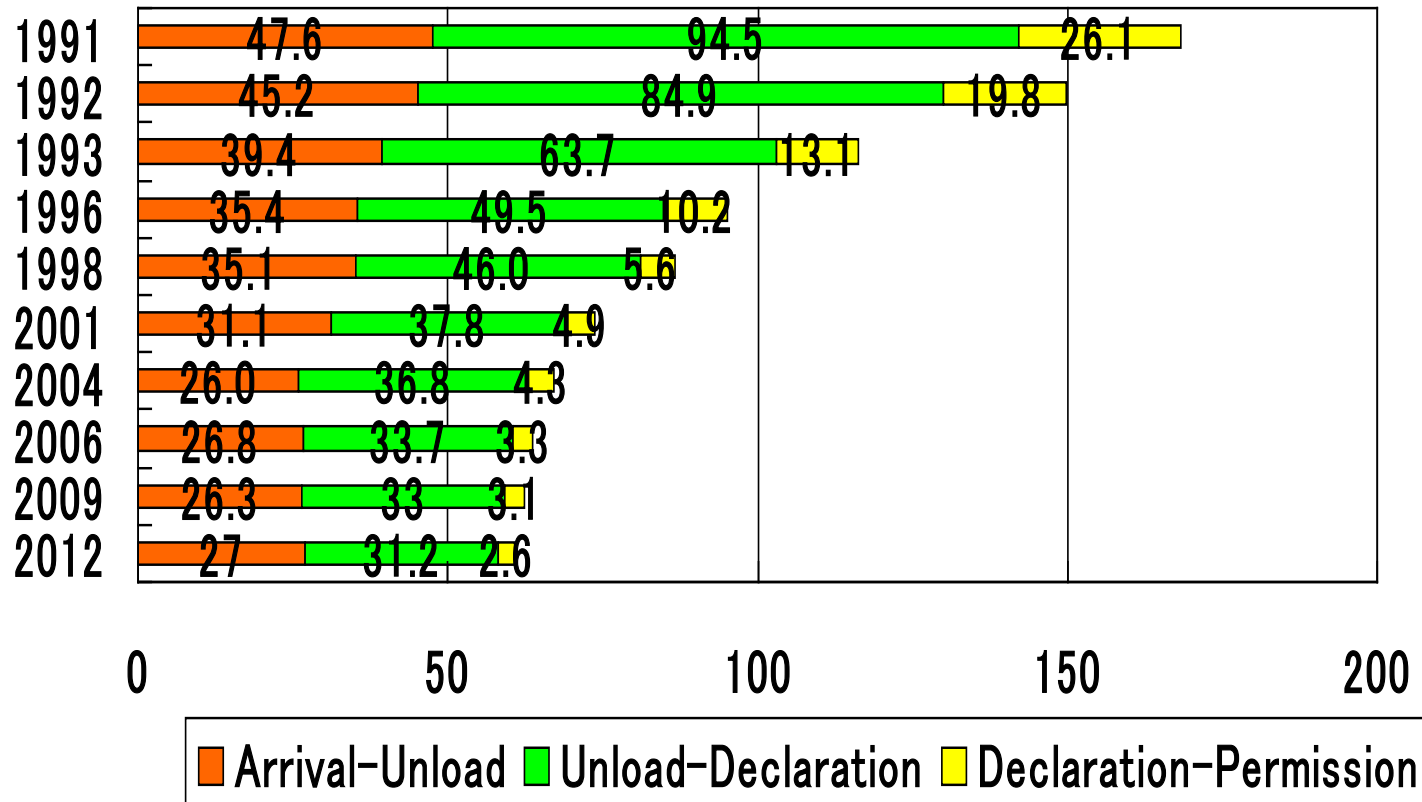

CBM to Facilitate Trade

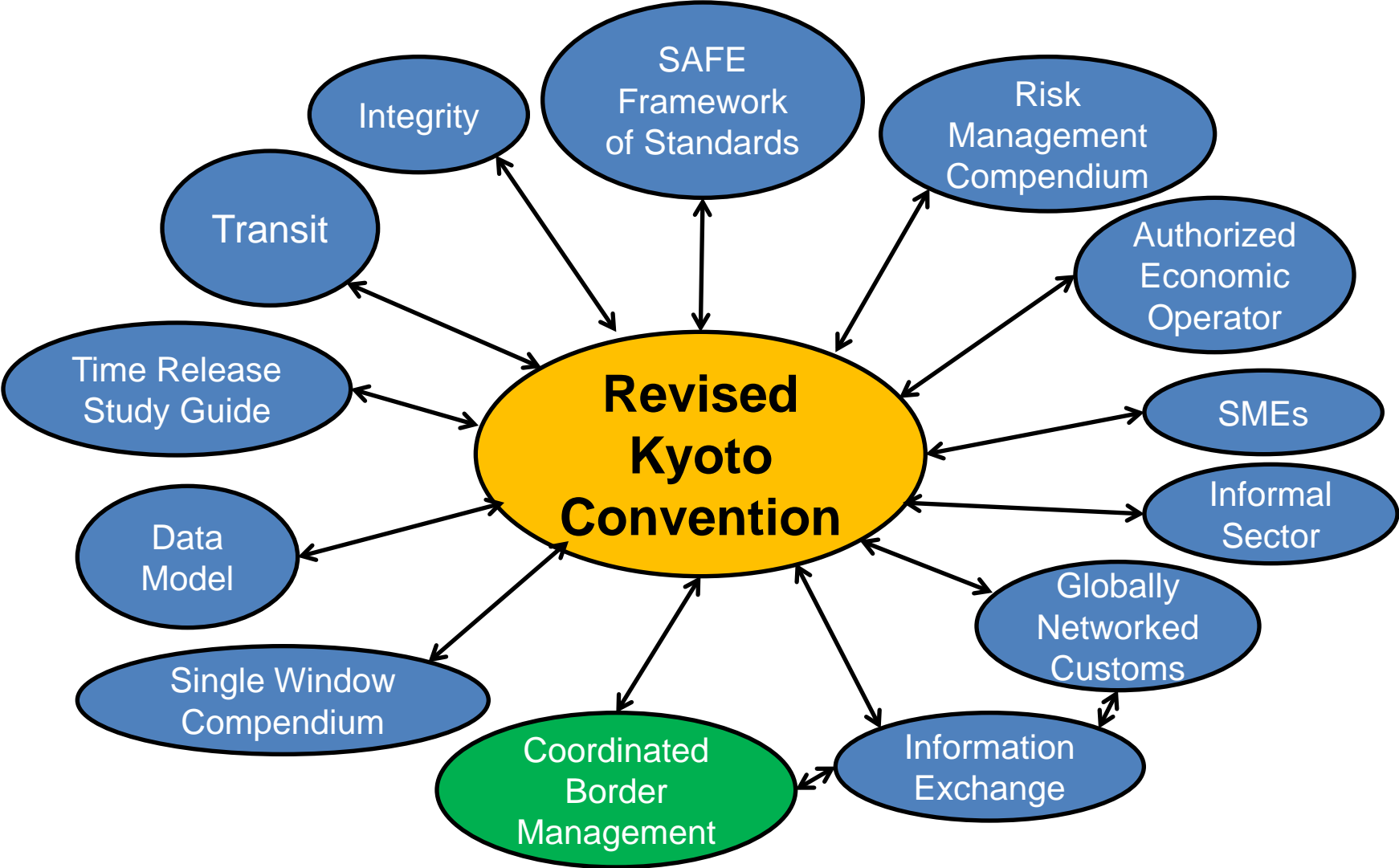
- Negotiations on Trade Facilitation (WTO)
 - ✓ *Article 10.5: Single Window/One-time Submission*
 - ✓ *Article 9: Border Agency Cooperation*
- Trade costs reduced by 5.4% through CBM (OECD 2011 study)
- CBM is important, because (World Bank):
 - ✓ Border management remains one of the most problematic links in the global supply chain
 - ✓ Customs is only responsible for a third of border delays, according to the World Bank, etc.

Time Release Study (Japan Sea Cargo)



Customs procedures accounted for only 5% (2.6 hours) of the total waiting time at borders (50.8 hours) in 2012

Coordinated Border Management

The number of government agencies at the border; more than 15 agencies (DFID 2008)

Various types of CBM

- ❖ Regular meetings among agencies (domestic/international)
- ❖ Joint physical examination (domestic/international)
- ❖ Enforcement Cooperation; e.g., Customs and Police
- ❖ One roof or one room among multiple agencies (domestic)
- ❖ Mutual recognition of physical examination (International)
- ❖ One Stop Border Post (OSBP) (International)
- ❖ Delegation of authority to other agency (domestic/international)
- ❖ Electronic Single Window (domestic/international)
- ❖ Single Border Agency (e.g., US, Canada, Australia)
