List of international conventions in customs area that Georgia has signed:


- 1. International convention on harmonized commodity description and coding system (**HS convention**) since 2009
- 2. Convention on Containers since 1999
- 3. International convention on mutual administrative assistance for the prevention, investigation and repression of customs offences (Nairobi convention) since 2009
- 4. International convention on harmonization of frontier controls of goods since 1999
- 5. Customs convention on international transport of goods under cover of TIR carnets (TIR convention) since 1994
- 6. Convention on the contract for the international carriage of goods by road (CMR convention) since 1999
- 7. Customs convention on Temporary admission of goods (Istanbul convention)- since 2010



 - Post Audit











Possibility to obtain the certificates and permits directly on Customs Crossing Points or in Customs Clearance Zones being specified in the electronically submitted documents while giving the possibility to use less time for the documentary submission in different places and just to finish all the procedures in one place
