




Customs Reforms

Border Crossing Points

In case of standard procedures – in average 25 minutes

In case of red corridor – average one hour

Advance Declaration Case



In case of green corridor - average 10 minutes (passport data registration control and customs procedures)

Clearance Zones

In case of standard procedures – in average 30 minutes

In case of red corridor – several hours in average

Payment of Customs Duty, Import VAT and Import Excise can be deferred for 5 days

In case of advance declaration Customs Duty, Import VAT and Import Excise can be deferred for 15 days



Meaning of Customs Clearance Zone (CCZ)



CCZ – Centers for goods Clearance:


- Located on several hectares
- With modern infrastructure, and
- With specially planned parking zone

Place, where customs declarations are filled and goods/cargo are cleared









Customs Clearance Zone – Clearance Options

- Clearance at CCZ
- **Advance Declaration**
- Distant Declaration
- Clearance of goods of single consignee/recipient



Clearance of Goods at CCZ

- Submission of documents and presentation of transport means at CCZ
- > Usually, 2 documents are required for clearance
- ➤ Service fees 150, 300, 400 GEL
- > Possibility of using 5 days deferred tax payment



Advance Declaration

- In case of advance declaration, goods are in importer's disposal directly from the border
- In case of advance declaration:
 - ✓ 15 days deferred payment of taxes and service fees is in place
 - ✓ Service fees are not doubled in case of off hours

3 possibilities of advance declaration:

- 1. by submission of documents to CCZ
- 2. by sending documents via www.rs.ge
- 3. by submission of already filled declaration (service fees: 100, 200, 300 GEL)



Distant Declaration

- > Declaration might be cleared from any place, despite the goods location
- ➤ If goods are located in Tbilisi, and importer is in Batumi, importer can clear goods in Tbilisi via electronic signature





Clearance of Single Consignee Goods

> Single consignee goods can be cleared in the place (non-control zone) indicated by importer

- > 4 different ways of declaration
 - Importer submits documents at CCZ
 - Importer electronically sends documents via <u>www.rs.ge</u>
 - ➤ Importer submits declaration through ASYCUDA
 - Clearance in the premises of importer: Clearance group (CCZ officer and "red corridor" officer) visits premises of importer and clears goods. No service fee is applicable for this additional service.



Benefits for importers/exporters

- ✓ Simplified import/export procedures

In 2006 the new Customs Code

- brutal reality conveying in itself the fighting against the corruption and the detection of corruption schemes, eradication of crime and punishment
- * modernised system: the new Customs Code with the corresponding secondary legislations providing with the detailed customs procedures
- Customs duties elimination of 16 customs duty dates, replacing them with a zero rate for 79. 42% of imports and two other rates (5 percent and 12 percent)
- intensive searches, inspections, and passport checks this strict approach created frictions that eventually led to confrontations.
- Border control- Georgia Revenue Service and Border Police (Border Police later replace by Patrol Police)
- non-existence of the qualified staff
- unhealthy environment for the business sector
 important obstacles for the business sector the absence of advance ruling practice

- Consolidation of Primary Legislation
- fair, simple and reliable customs system:

- Electronic administration system
- Modern infrastructure
- personal tax and customs liability account
- Simplified customs procedures and target customs control
- First generation of non-corrupted customs officers
 24 hours supporting toll free
- Liberalized trade
