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



Draft Action Plan – 3 Goals



- Establishment of competitive corridors across the CAREC region
- Facilitation of efficient movement across borders
- Development of sustainable, safe, and user– friendly transport and trade networks

Action Plan supports broad based actions:

- Competitive Corridor Development and Management
- Trade Facilitation
- Sustainability Enhancement



Draft Action Plan

Competitive Corridor Development and Management

- Outcomes
 - Increased transit and intraregional trade
 - Reduced transport costs and travel time
 - Improved regional transport network with sufficient funding for maintenance and private sector participation
- Milestones and Indicators (by 5th and 10th year)
 - CAREC corridors: 75% -> 100%
 - Increased transit trade: 2% -> 5%
 - Reduced time at borders: 50% -> 20%
 - Maintenance: \$1,000/km/year (by 10 years)



Trade Facilitation

- Outcomes
 - Improved efficiency in Customs operations with appropriate risk management, increased transit trade, and increased in number of skilled staff
 - Increased transit and intraregional trade
 - Improved logistics industry
- Milestones and Indicators (by 5th and 10th year)
 - Increased transit trade: 2% -> 5%
 - Increased intraregional trade: 50% -> 100%
 - Reduced time at borders: 50% -> 20%



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Sustainability Enhancement

- Outcomes
 - Reduced pollution and accidents
 - Improved civil aviation safety
 - Improved mobility of people
- Milestones and Indicators (by 5th and 10th year)
 - Increased number of transport equipment meeting the international standards: 30%->50%
 - Reduced road and air accidents: 20% -> 50%



- Investment and TA Projects

Next 10 Years

- 68 investment projects: about \$28 billion
 - New: 47 Projects (\$19 billion)
 - Ongoing: 21 Projects (\$9 billion)
- 62 TA Projects: about \$62 million






Show Case Corridors for Corridor Performance Monitoring


- All CAREC DMCs expressed their desires to include CAREC corridors traversing through their countries for pilot performance assessment, during the 2nd consultation (February-March 2008)


























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
