Use of TRS



Useful tool for:

- Diagnostics: Validating issues to inform interventions
- Monitoring: Setting baseline and measurable performance improvements

NOT a solution

Packaged measures with repeated TRS desirable

Objectives of the workshop on TRS



- Provide training on the methodology and tools available to conduct TRS
- Facilitate the exchange of information and experience among customs officials
- Enable customs officials to explore options for employing the TRS to deepen customs cooperation among CAREC countries

Outcomes of TRS



TRS will assist administrations to:

- Identify the constraints affecting customs/other agencies clearance
- Consider corrective actions
- Identify areas requiring simplification in procedures
