Key Issues in the Energy Sector Work Plan 2013 - 2015

- ❑ Selection of optimum schemes for the integration of energy resources (electricity and gas) of the Central Asian countries with South Asia energy markets
- ❑ Resolution of power dispatch issues in the Central Asian countries to optimize power flows between these countries
- ❑ Implementation of modeling and analytical tools, institutional development, and capacity building for the management of energy-water linkages in the Central Asian countries

Key Issues in the Energy Sector

- ❑ Mobilization of funds for rehabilitating and building energy infrastructure within the CAREC region for meeting domestic demand and for cross-border energy trade
- ❑ Identification, implementation, and monitoring of medium-term (2012-2014) priority projects, based on national and regional priorities, taking into account the projects prioritization plan outlined in the Regional Power Master Plan
- ❑ Assessment of capacity development and knowledge management needs and the implementation of targeted programs, in collaboration with the CAREC Institute, and with the support of development partners
