# Draft Action Plan - Format Developed based on the Indicative Result Framework attached to the Transport and Trade Facilitation Strategy (10 years from 2008)




# Draft Action Plan – 3 Goals





### **Survey method**

- Conducted by transport operators
- Quarterly
- Record the time and costs incurred in transporting goods from a point to a point along CAREC corridors

- Time-Release method

- To propose solutions



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
