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


Trading at Borders


Thailand is surrounded by four neighbouring countries and has borders which are connected for about 5,500 kilometres.

Permanent checkpoints, Temporary checkpoints, Flexible checkpoints, spread throughout 31 bordering provinces and cover 45 Customs Houses











Definitions

Customs Control →

Measures applied to ensure compliance with the laws and regulations which customs are responsible for enforcing

Control Efficiency →

Customs control should be kept to the minimum necessary to meet the main objectives and should be carried out on a selective basis using risk management techniques to the greatest extent as possible in accommodate rapid changes of global trading environment
