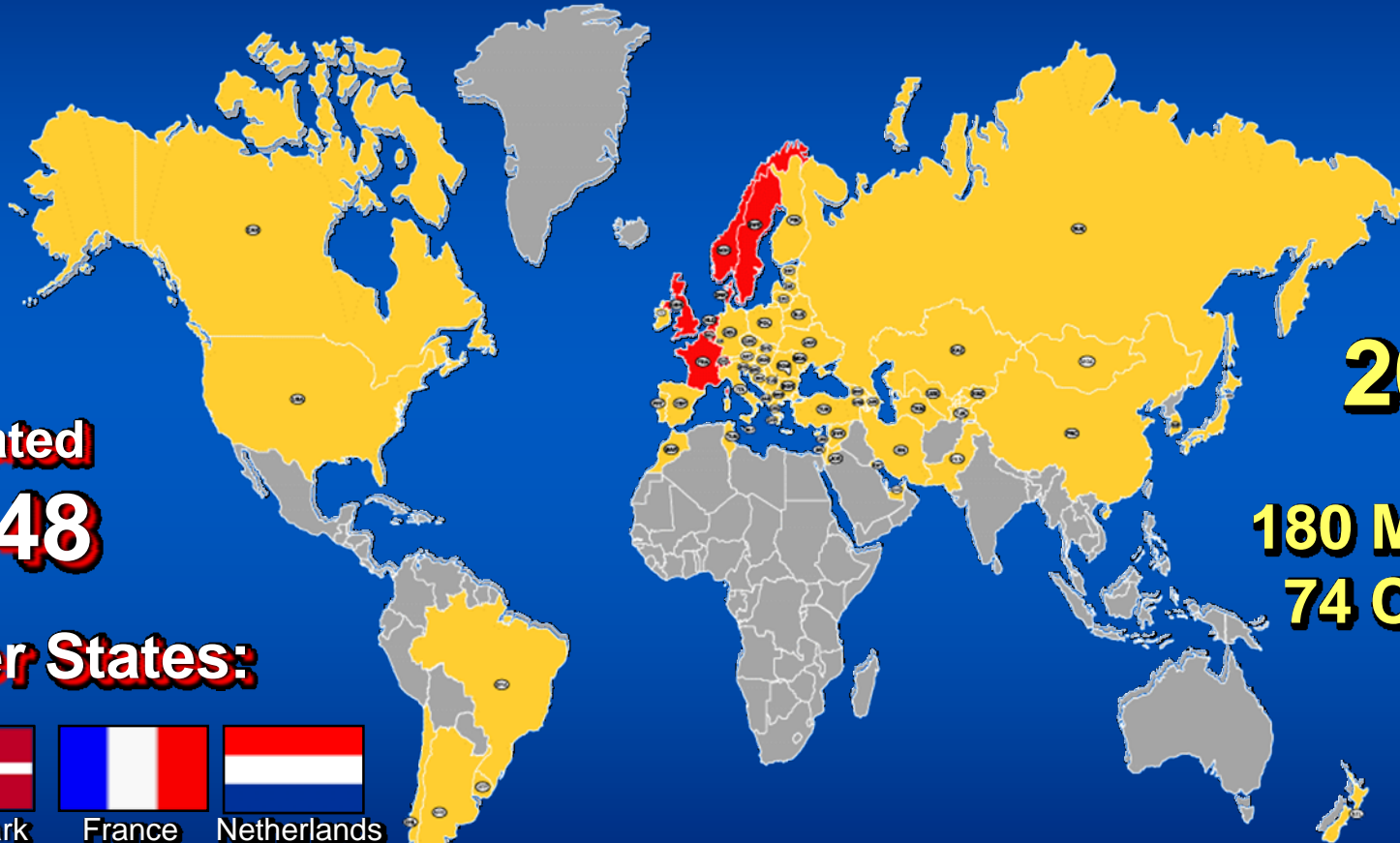

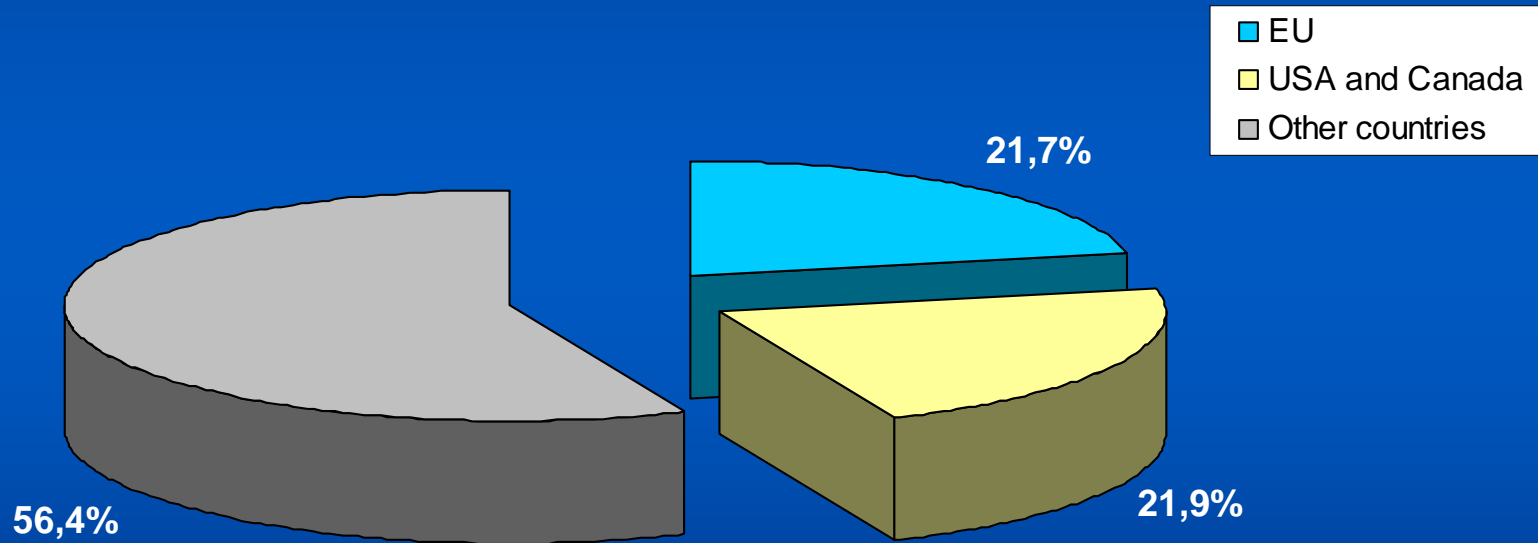

Export of goods from China, 1994-2008, US\$ Billions

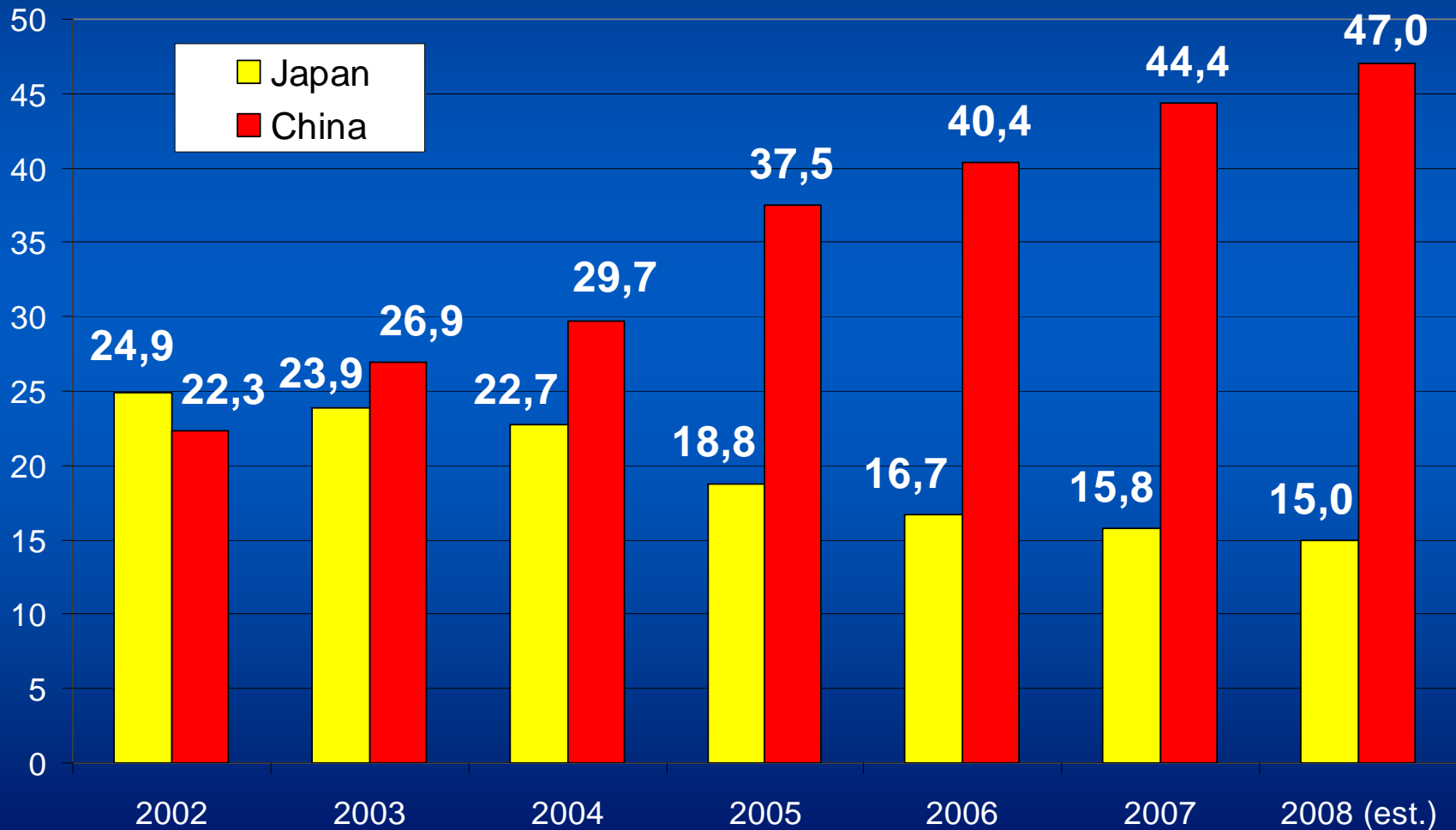


Exports from China to EU and US, %

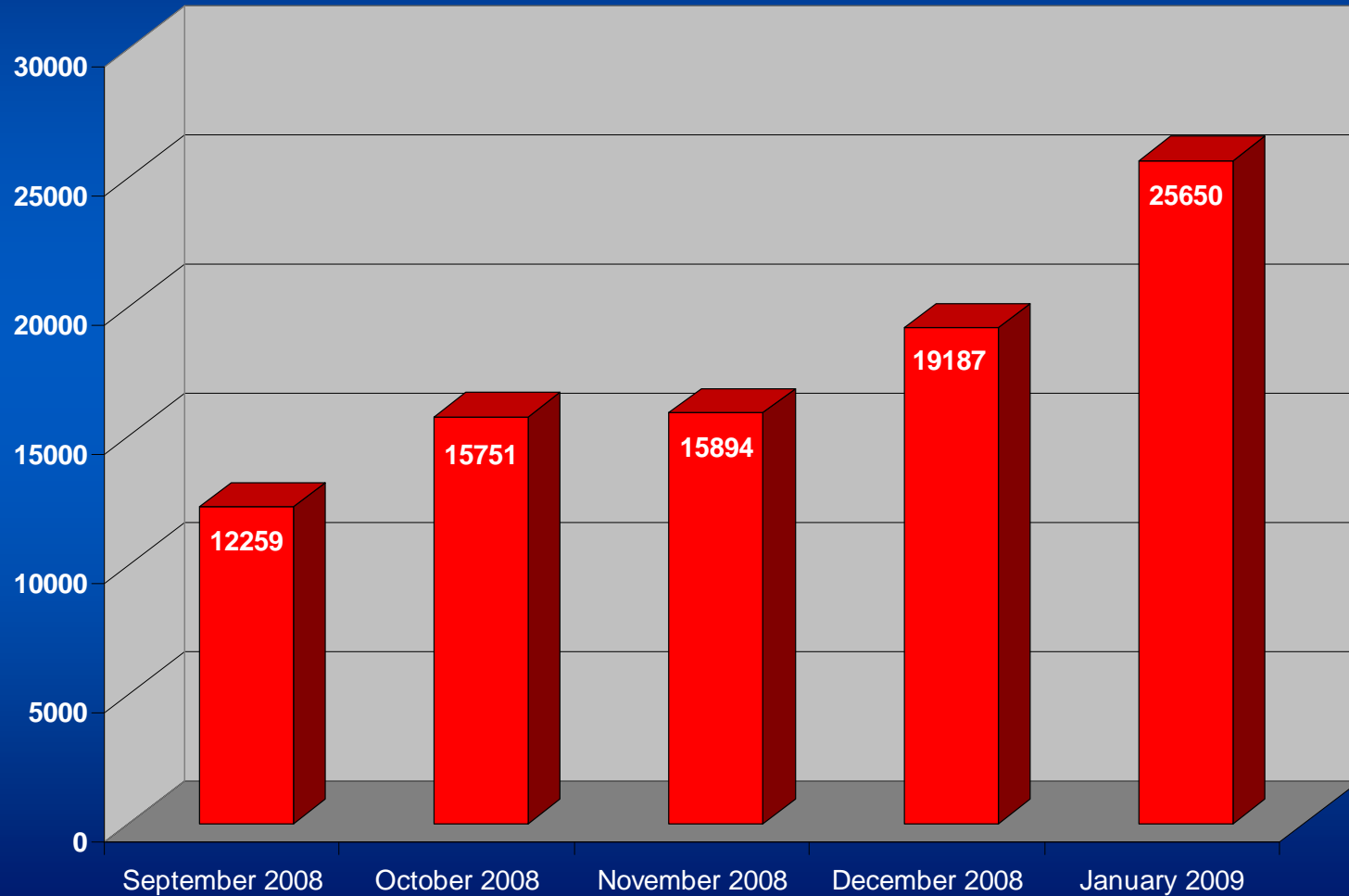




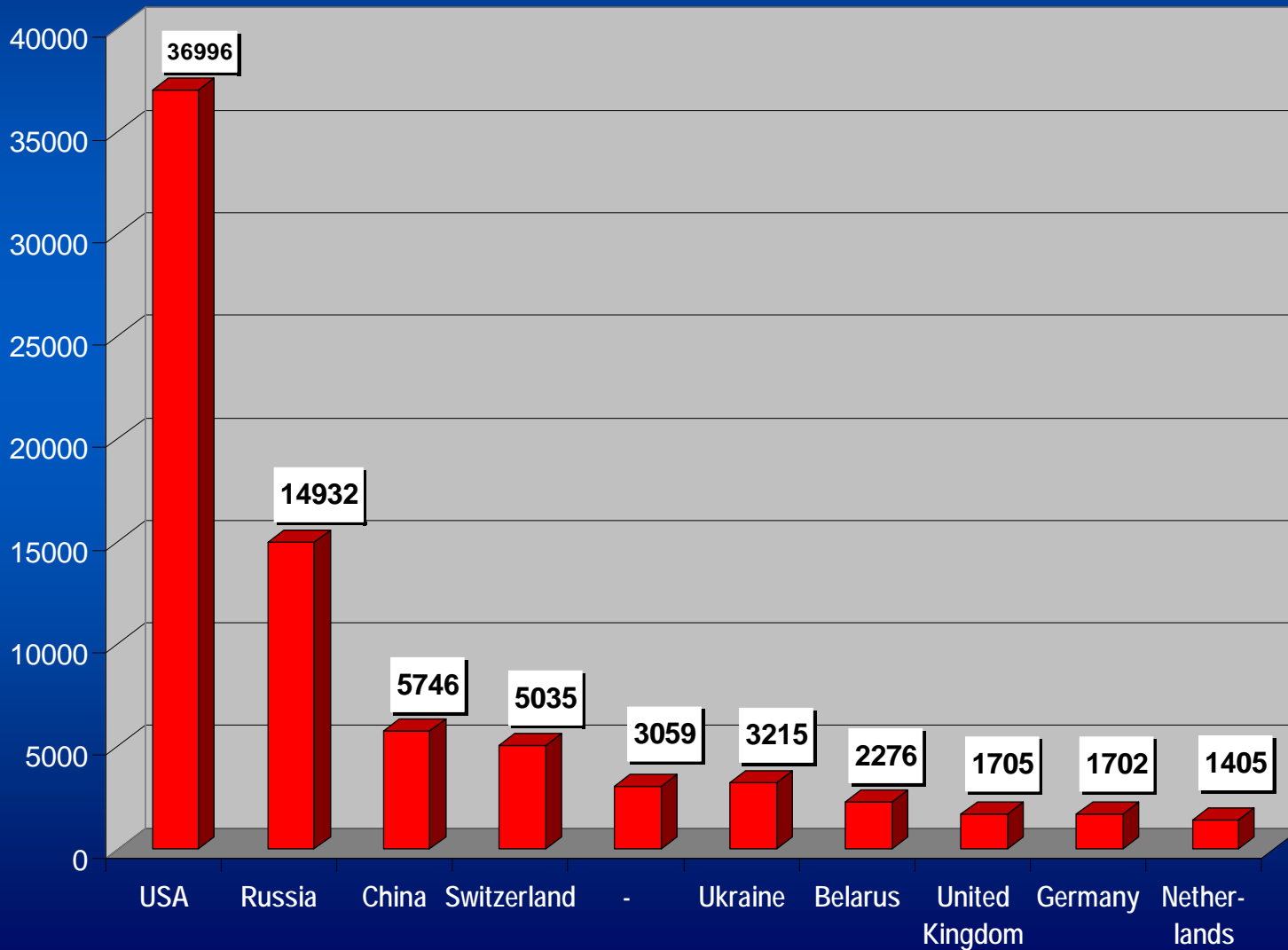

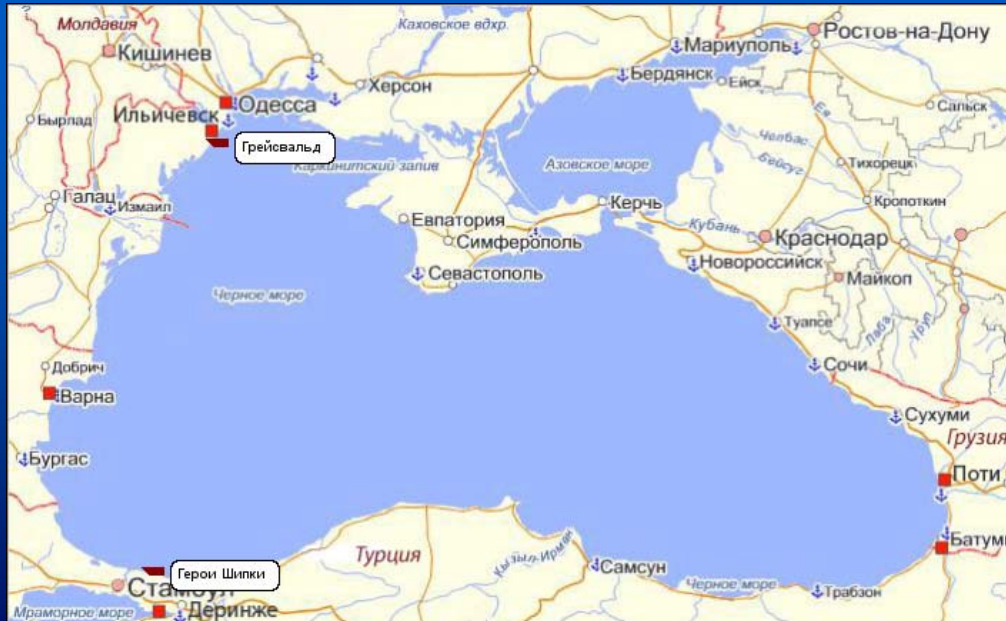


Visitors by countries of origin
