
#### Recommendations

### National Joint Trade Training Committee

- To collate and compile information on its members' identified training needs and newly-developed capacity;
- To identify existing local solutions where possible;
- Where a local solution does not exist, to create a needs document outlining the circumstances of the need and report to the Regional committee;
- To report new capacity to the Regional Committee;
- To identify local recipients of "train the trainers" development in externally delivered subjects;
- To seek feedback on the effectiveness of delivered training;
- To update the CAREC training database with potential national contributions;
- To identify and apply for funding in support of Nationallyidentified needs.

### Regional Joint Trade Training Committee


- To collate and compile information on national training committees' identified training needs and newly-developed capacity;
- To identify existing CAREC regional solutions where available;
- To identify CAREC-wide common needs;
- To identify Regional needs on a strategic level;
- To liaise with CCC and other CAREC regional groups;
- To source external training support where appropriate;
- To oversee the maintenance of a CAREC regional database;
- To identify and apply for funding in support of Regionallyidentified needs.

- Risk Management Techniques in a Trade Facilitation Environment
  - Introduce practical techniques
  - Anti-smuggling & fiscal risk
  - Mix of classroom and supervised practical work
  - Tutors with practical experience

#### Post-customs control

- For managers and operational staff
- Auditing at traders premises
- Interface with risk management
- Partnership approach to control

#### Trade Awareness for Border Control Staff

- Aimed at operational staff
- Gives a trade context to border control work
- Promote understanding of trade practices and priorities
- Promote cooperation and communication

#### Legislative Reform & Trade Facilitation

- Aimed at those responsible for drafting new legislation
- WTO and other standards
- Classroom/workshop sessions
- Tutors with relevant practical experience

- Regional General Logistics Development Programme
  - Aimed at forwarders and logistics providers
  - Increase professionalism
  - Develop skills & knowledge
  - Modular approach
  - Affiliation/certification?

#### Customs for Logistics Practitioners

- Aimed at forwarders and logistics providers
- Delivered in-country/distance learning
- Develop knowledge of national customs procedures & requirements
