

PROGRESS ON RE-BOOTING QUADRILATERAL AGREEMENT ON TRAFFIC IN TRANSIT

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QUADRILATERAL AGREEMENT

- The Agreement on Traffic in Transit was signed by Pakistan, China, Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan on 09th March 1995 in Islamabad.
- The allied Protocols to the Quadrilateral Agreement are:
- Protocol on Custom Procedures for traffic in transit and Visa Regime signed in July, 1996.
- Protocol on establishing system of International Road Transit Permit for traffic in transit among the contracting parties in November, 1998.
- **Regulations** for implementation of Agreement on traffic in transit among contracting parties signed in November, 1998.

SALIENT FEATURES

- Enforced in May 2004 and traffic in transit remained in operation till landslide on Karakoram Highway in January 2010.
- The 24 Km road segment affected due to landslide has now been restored in September 2015 after hectic efforts of Pakistani and Chinese Engineers.
- The traffic operates on Transport Permits system.
- The quota limit for permits for each country per year is 200.
- This quota limitation is adjustable with the consent of Member Governments.

SALIENT FEATURES

- One permit is valid for one round trip only with permission to carry return load.
- The permit is non-transferable.
- The permit issued in December of one Calendar Year can be extended to January of next Calendar Year by the issuing authority.
- The border post authorities of the Contracting Parties at the border post check the permits of the vehicles performing traffic in transit.





QTTA TRANSPORT PERMIT Front Page

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NOTES

The vehicles performing the traffic in transit between PRC, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic and Pakistan shall have the International Road Transit Permit and shall run along the designated corridors, set in Regulations of Quadrilateral Traffic in Transit Agreement (QTTA) as follows: Karachi Sea Ports (Pakistan) to Peshawar (N-55) or Karachi Sea Ports to Islamabad/Rawalpindi

Dry Port (N-5 or Motorways) to Hassanabdal-Gilgit-Sust (Pakistan) – Khunjerab (China) – Kashgar – Torugart (China) – Torugart (Kyrgyzstan) – Bishkek – Ak-Jol (Kyrgyzstan) – Kordai (Kazakhstan) – Almaty – Khorgos (Kazakhstan) – Khorgos (China), and vice versa

The permit shall be carried with the vehicle and shall be checked by the authorized agencies. The Permit is valid only for the international road transport and shall not be used as internal or bilateral road transport permit. The permit shall not be transferred to the non - contracting parties, vehicles.

INDUCTION OF TIR SYSTEM IN QTTA

- Induction of globally acceptable TIR Guaranteeing System within QTTA
- To make the TIR System operational by July 2016 in Pakistan, following measures have been taken;
 - 6 border Customs Stations have notified as eligible for handling TIR Cargo in Pakistan.
 - TIR Rules have been drafted and are currently being reviewed by a Review Committee.
 - Necessary hardware & software have been procured for establishing electronic linkage between WeBOC and IRU
- Technical Assistance from IRU is needed for Establishing System in Ministry of Communications for Certification & Approval for Road Vehicles (Implementation of Article-12 of TIR Convention)
