Regional Aviation Safety Groups

- RASGs serve as a regional cooperative forum to enhance aviation safety
- Develop and implement work programmes
- Build on the work already done by States and sub-regional organizations
- Support the establishment and operation of a performance-based safety system for the region.
- RASG meeting reports regularly reviewed by the ANC, and by the Council as deemed necessary.
