Trade Policy Strategic Action Plan

- Progress in trade liberalization
- Vigorous pursuit of WTO accession
- Capacity-building activities to support intraregional and international trade

- Discussing training for WTO accession
- Identifying institutional impediments to trade

Monitoring Trade Liberalization Measures

- A draft questionnaire was discussed
- The questionnaire will collect information on trade liberalization, and reducing impediments to transit & trade in 2009-12
- Questionnaire will be filled once a year
- IMF will monitor progress



Training on WTO Accession

- The World Bank presented a seminar
- Discussions focused on requirements, benefits & costs of accession
- Follow up actions include sharing experiences between countries and further training on WTO accession



Institutional Impediments to Trade

- An outline of a study on institutional barriers was discussed
- Delegates will provide inputs to finish the study
- Draft for discussion in the next TPCC meeting



Future Work Program: Trade Liberalization

By 2010:

- ✓ Reduce number of non-zero tariff bands
- ✓ Reduce impediments to transit trade
- Eliminate export QRs and half of import QRs
- ✓ Apply VAT and excises on imports uniformly
- ✓ Eliminate miscellaneous charges, fees, taxes
- Cut maximum tariff by half



Future Work Program: WTO Accession

- ✓ Advance trade liberalization measures
- Seminars on global experiences
- ✓ Bilateral workshops between CAREC WTO members and candidate countries



Future Work Program: Institutional Impediments to Trade

- ✓ The study in preparation will provide a framework to identify impediments
- ✓ The study will recommend ways of addressing them
