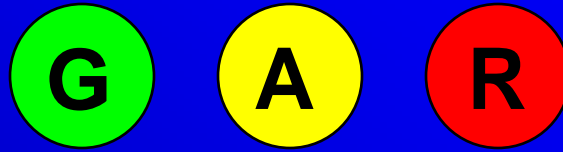

# 2010 CAREC DEfR: Highlights

- Progress was made in 2010
- First year of comparative results
- Successes and challenges
- Rating system



“On track”: indicator value has made progress and improved on the indicator value reflected in the previous DEfR cycle.



“Stalled”: indicator value has neither made progress nor deteriorated since the previous cycle. Necessary action should be identified to prevent further deterioration.



“Off track”: indicator value has deteriorated for two consecutive years. Immediate attention is required.

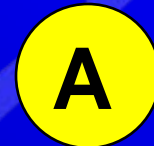

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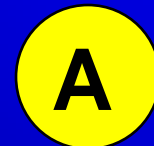

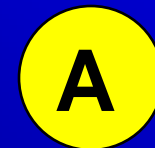

# Actions Carried Over from DEfR 2009

## Level 1:

- Develop subnational data sourcing

## Level 2:

- Refine indicators and data monitoring systems
- Identify targets for relevant indicators at Levels 2 and 3

## Level 3:

- Develop project portfolio database
- Develop external relations plan
- Strengthen CAREC Institute capacity
- Identify knowledge production indicators



# Proposed New Actions: 2010

## Level 1:

- Improve sourcing of poverty data

## Level 2:

- Capture a fuller picture of CAREC's performance
- Address DEfR Actions in sector coordinating committee meetings
- Consider implications of CAREC 2020 and the MTPP

## Level 3:

- Complete upgrading of CAREC website
- Identify priority publication needs
- Expand media monitoring activities
