Challenges and opportunities

- E-commerce a very data-rich environment, in which Customs could potentially embrace voluminous data concerning trade in goods
- Security concerns fight against terrorism/violent extremism/organized crimes with predictive analytics
- Emerging threats money laundering/ terrorist financing

- Data quality/Data integrity

- A cost/benefit analysis to be performed before introducing an IT solution
- Training required for proper utilization of IT solutions
