- **Data** – new opportunities to advance mission-critical objectives
- **Quality** data obtained in a **timely** manner
- **Harmonization** of data to be circulated
- **Skills** to be developed pursuant to the IT challenges
- **Privacy** and **confidentiality** laws

WORLD CUSTOMS ORGANIZATION

⦿ Challenges and opportunities

- **Standards** – data formats
- **Risk management** – crucial questions about data accuracy, availability and admissibility in decision making
- **Internet of Things (IoT)** – Customs would be able to concentrate on their analytical tasks, while having commercial operators function as 'caretakers'

WORLD CUSTOMS ORGANIZATION

⦿ Challenges and opportunities

- **E-commerce** – a very data-rich environment, in which Customs could potentially embrace voluminous data concerning trade in goods
- **Security concerns** – fight against terrorism/violent extremism/organized crimes with predictive analytics
- **Emerging threats** – money laundering/terrorist financing

WORLD CUSTOMS ORGANIZATION

● ***Objective***

- Be aware of certain trading patterns
- Selectivity (cargoes/travelers)
- Trade facilitation effect

WORLD CUSTOMS ORGANIZATION

● ***Data collection***

- Data quality/Data integrity
- Private sector burden / Feedback (incentive) mechanism
- Interoperability of systems
- Cooperation with and support from other governmental agencies (or partner agencies)

● *IT solutions*

- Open source tools for data analysis
- A cost/benefit analysis to be performed before introducing an IT solution
- Training required for proper utilization of IT solutions
- Insourced/outsourced

- ◎ **E-commerce** and risk management
 - Lack of data, poor data quality
- ◎ **Data exchange** mechanism
 - Question of trust in the data being provided
 - Necessity of standardized requirements
- ◎ **Utilization of data**
 - The right data, from the right people, at the right time
