Short- and long-term cooperation to strengthen strategic partnership between GCF and GGGI



Strategic Partnership

- GCF - GGGI MOU and Framework Grant Agreement signed on April 14th
- GGGI accreditation no longer a strategic priority
- Country readiness support while pursuing long-term cooperation goals (e.g. joint capacity development and peer-to-peer knowledge exchange)

Readiness and Preparatory Support

- Readiness proposals with GGGI as Delivery Partner in 12-15 countries in 2017.
 - Build capacity of direct access Accredited Entities (DAEs);
 - Support accreditation of candidate DAEs and upgrade existing DAEs to higher accreditation category;
 - Improve quality of project proposals and develops projects pipelines;
 - Support countries to develop Country Program (define country priorities, short- and long-term projects/programs and an action plan).

Short- and long-term cooperation to strengthen strategic partnership between GCF and GGGI



Capacity Building

- Bespoke interventions at country level under Readiness program
- Possible Joint Structured Dialogues in Latin America and Africa in 2017
- Long-term GCF-GGGI Capacity Building Program (e.g. regional peer-to-peer learning, mentoring etc. for NDAs and DAEs)

Economic Analysis

- Cooperate to build GCF's capacity in providing macro-economic analysis/ gap analysis to put funding proposals as well as readiness proposals into the national economic context; and
- Better understand wider economic impact of project proposals and program.

Administrative Cooperation

- Relevant divisions and units of both organizations will actively discuss possible cooperation in administrative operations (i.e. ICT, Travel, Finance, HR and etc.)
