Upgrading Customs Legislation

- Customs legislation is fully based on adopted international standards
- The Customs Code of Turkmenistan is aligned with the requirements of the Kyoto Convention on Harmonization and Unification of Customs Procedures



Information Technology Improvements

- cooperation with United Nations Conference on Trade and Development c for introduction of the Integrated Customs Information System in the customs service of Turkmenistan (ASICUDA). The project is expected to be completed in 2019.
- launching the system to identify vehicles' geolocation using GPS (Global Positioning System).



Structural Reforms

- establishing a new Analytical Division in the Head Office of the State Customs Service
- establishing the Economic Directorate to provide processing and storage services for shipments involved in international transport operations
- opening Turkmenbashi international port



Transport Infrastructure Development

- bridge crossings across the Amu-Darya along Turkmenabad Farap section
- a trunk railway linking Turkmenistan, Afghanistan and Tajikistan

 revival of the Great Silk Route in the new capacity in the territory of Turkmenistan



International Cooperation

 interaction with the International Customs Organization, various UN structures, such as the UN Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), the UN Development Program (UNDP), as well as BOMCA and CAREC

concluding international agreements
