Key Roles of Carrier Associations



National road carrier associations, uniting a large number of companies, ...

Protect interests of the national transport companies – association members, and assist in the development of their businesses

Participate in the development, evaluation and putting forward proposals regarding the development/ implementation of national legislation, so far as it relates to transport

Monitor road transportation and market conditions, identify issues and bottlenecks

Conduct continuous professional development of the management and personnel of transport companies, identify the most promising trends and lines of business

Develop and introduce up-to-date innovative products and solutions that ease the work of the transport sector professionals

Act as guaranteeing associations under the TIR Convention (1975), and take responsibility for the operation of TIR System at the national level

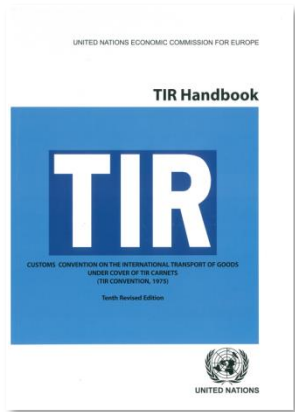
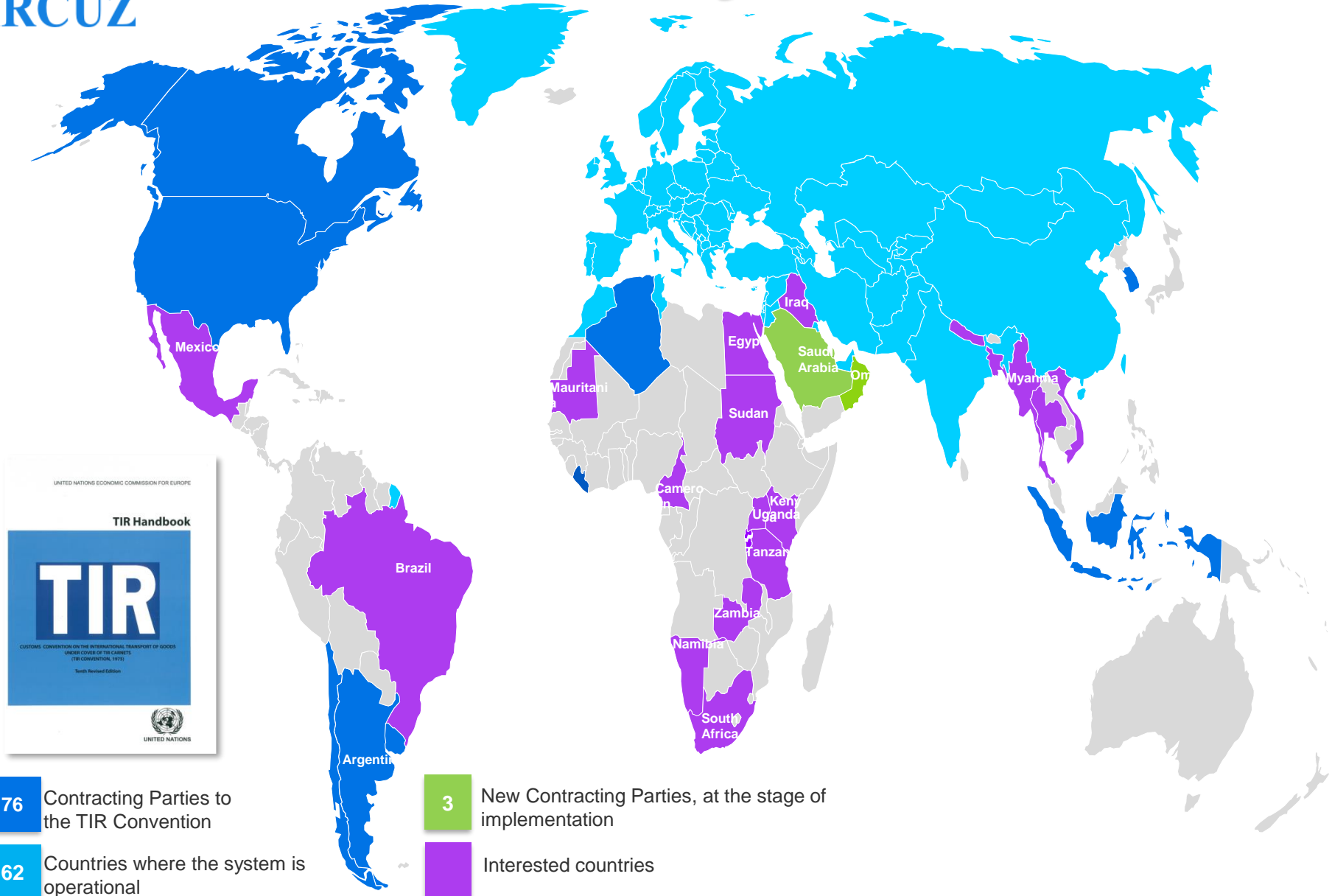

TIR System

TIR in figures

Operates in 62 countries worldwide

Used by over 30,000 companies

~ 1.2 mil. TIR carnets are issued annually

~ 23,000,000 tons of goods are hauled annually

~USD16 bn - value of the hauled goods

Interactions between Associations

Carriers

- 1) Facilitation;
- 2) Development proposals;
- 3) International cooperation;
- 4) Training and professional development;
- 5) Guaranteeing operations

Government

- 1) Provision of assistance;
- 2) Highlighting bottlenecks, and proposals on improvement;
- 3) Expert opinion on the best practices and international experience issues

Business

- 1) Establishing effective business communication;
- 2) Proposals on business projects;
- 3) Training in transportation topics;
- 4) Organizing joint events

International organizations

- 1) Interaction in the framework of projects;
- 2) Exchange of information;
- 3) Joint events on experience sharing and advanced practices;
- 4) Development of advanced solutions for carriers



Integrating core



AIRCUZ Example

- ❖ Provides assistance to the national transport companies in renewing rolling stocks, establishing joint ventures with foreign partners, and widening scope of their activities;
- ❖ Promotes advanced innovative solutions in transport business, using electronic technologies for the optimization of the operations, time, and costs (TIR-EPD, eTIR, eCMR);
- ❖ Training center affiliated with the Association provides training to the companies' personnel in: professional competency in international road transport, transport of dangerous goods, drivers' working and rest hours – use of tachographs, safe goods securing, etc.;
- ❖ Promotes new delivery routes for export goods, and works with partners on costs optimization on the existing and projected routes;
- ❖ Provides information on the conditions of international road haulage in foreign countries.

Proposals

- ❖ Conduct regional workshops/ training sessions for the competent bodies and business community representatives on experience sharing and best practices;
- ❖ Upgrade border crossing points and provide them with modern technology, enabling a high level of automation of all the procedures followed;
- ❖ Move the border crossing points to a "single window" system operation;
- ❖ Clear vehicles based on the risk criteria, with the introduction of special green lanes at the border crossing points for "safe vehicles" (availability of preliminary information, TIR System, transport of perishable goods)
- ❖ Harmonize standards applied to the weight and dimensions parameters of vehicles.
