

25-26 April: 18th Transport Sector Coordinating Committee Meeting

Venue: Radisson Blu, Tashkent

Background

CAREC member countries continue to work together in implementing the Transport and Trade Facilitation Strategy 2020 (TTFS 2020), which prioritizes the completion of the six strategic multimodal transport corridors. Beyond the implementation of physical investment projects, the TTFS 2020 also highlights CAREC countries' emphasis on the soft interventions, which are required to maximize the effectiveness of such investment projects. To this end, the rolling Transport Sector Work Plan (2018-2020) includes actions in the areas of (i) road asset management, (ii) road safety, (iii) transport facilitation, (iv) railways and (v) aviation.

During the 17th TSCC meeting held in Istanbul, Turkey on 18-20 April 2018, the CAREC member countries confirmed the need to prepare a new CAREC Transport Strategy 2030 to build on the progress achieved through TTFS 2020, deepen the work on all the transport subsectors, and align activities with the infrastructure agenda of the CAREC Strategy 2030.

Objectives

In light of the above, the 18th Transport Sector Coordinating Committee (TSCC) meeting will (i) review the implementation progress of the CAREC Transport and Trade Facilitation Strategy 2020 focusing on recent developments in railways, road asset management, road safety, crossborder transport facilitation and aviation; (ii) deliberate on the draft *CAREC Transport Strategy 2030*; and (iii) develop an action plan for the CAREC Transport sector work leading to the implementation of the *CAREC Transport Strategy 2030*.
