### **Cross-Border Economic Zones**

#### Multi-tranche Financing Facility (MFF)

- <u>Xinjiang Regional Cooperation and Integration (RCI)</u>
  <u>Promotion Investment Program</u> to develop CBEZs at borders between Xinjiang (PRC), KAZ and MON
- Inner Mongolia (IMAR) RCI Promotion Investment
  Program to strengthen cooperation with IMAR neighboring countries on connectivity and crossborder trade including CBEZ development with MON

#### MON CBEZ project

- TRTA to support masterplan development and framework for policy and project coordination with PRC CBEZ
- MON site visit to PRC-KAZ Khorgos Intl Centre of Border Cooperation (Jun 2018)
- Investment in Zamyn-Uud CBEZ planned in 2020

### **Trade Finance**

- •ADB Trade Finance Program since 2009 provides guarantees and loans to banks and SMEs
  - In 2017, supported over \$1.6 billion trade transactions in CAREC (except PRC), 75% to SMEs
  - signed agreements with new partner banks in Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan
  - conference for trade finance professionals from 50 banks in Central Asia and MON
- ADB Supply Chain Finance Program is being expanded to cover CAREC countries
- Proposed Multilateral/Regional Trade Credit and Investment Guarantee Agency to include CAREC countries
