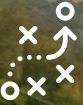

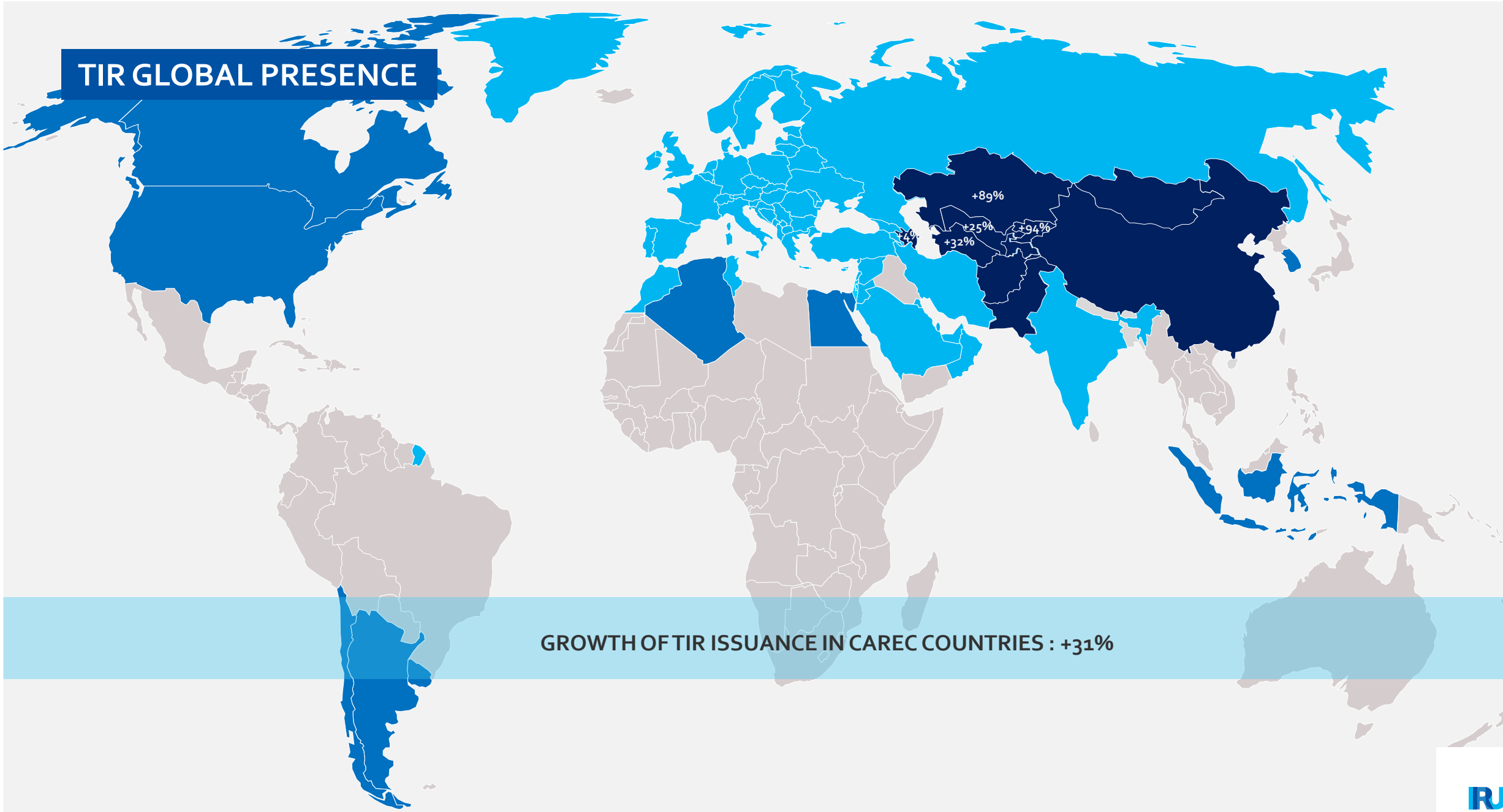

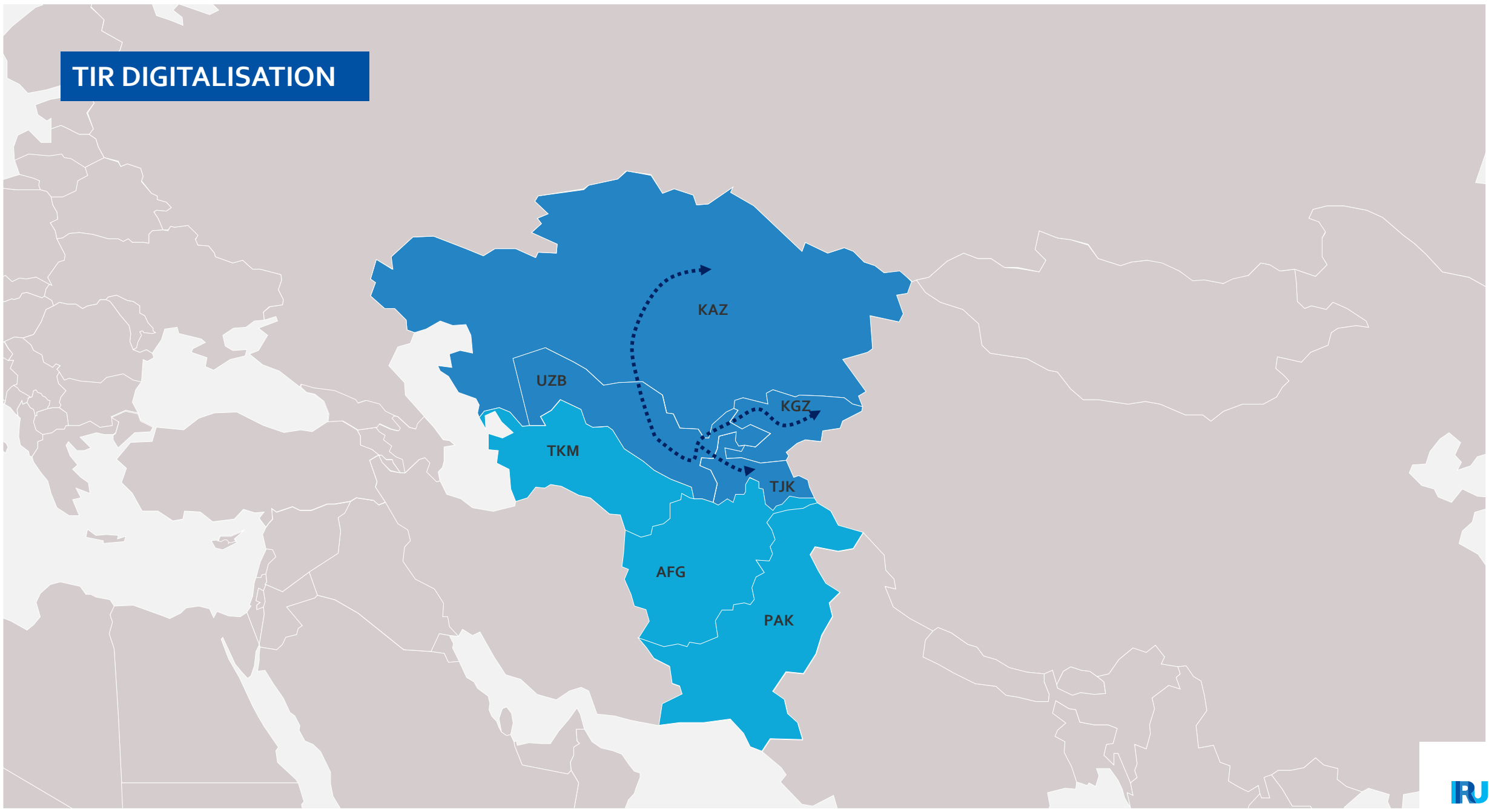

eCMR COVERAGE IN CAREC



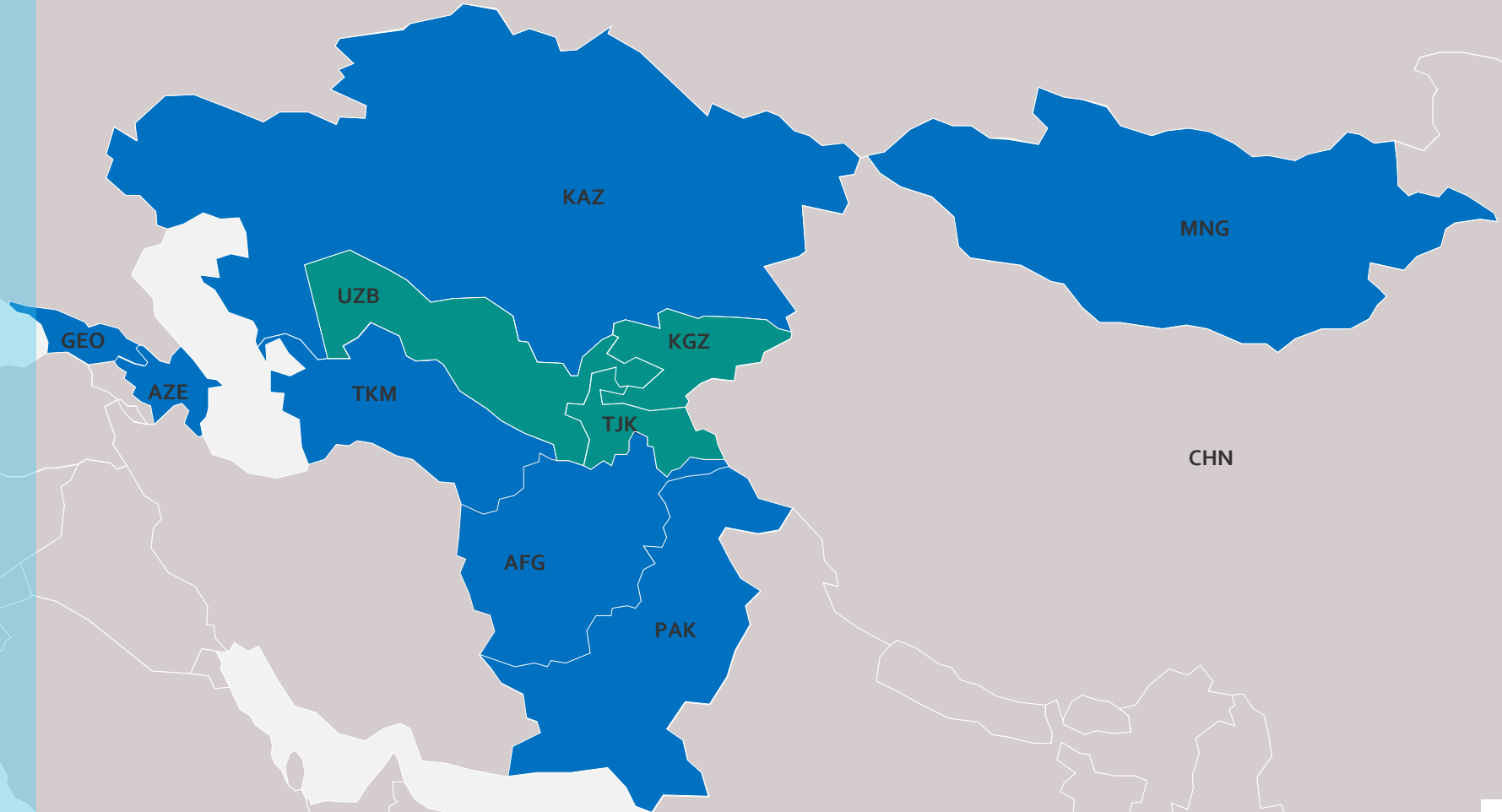
Harmoinised solution to reduce costs for both public and private sector

to make transit more secure and transparent

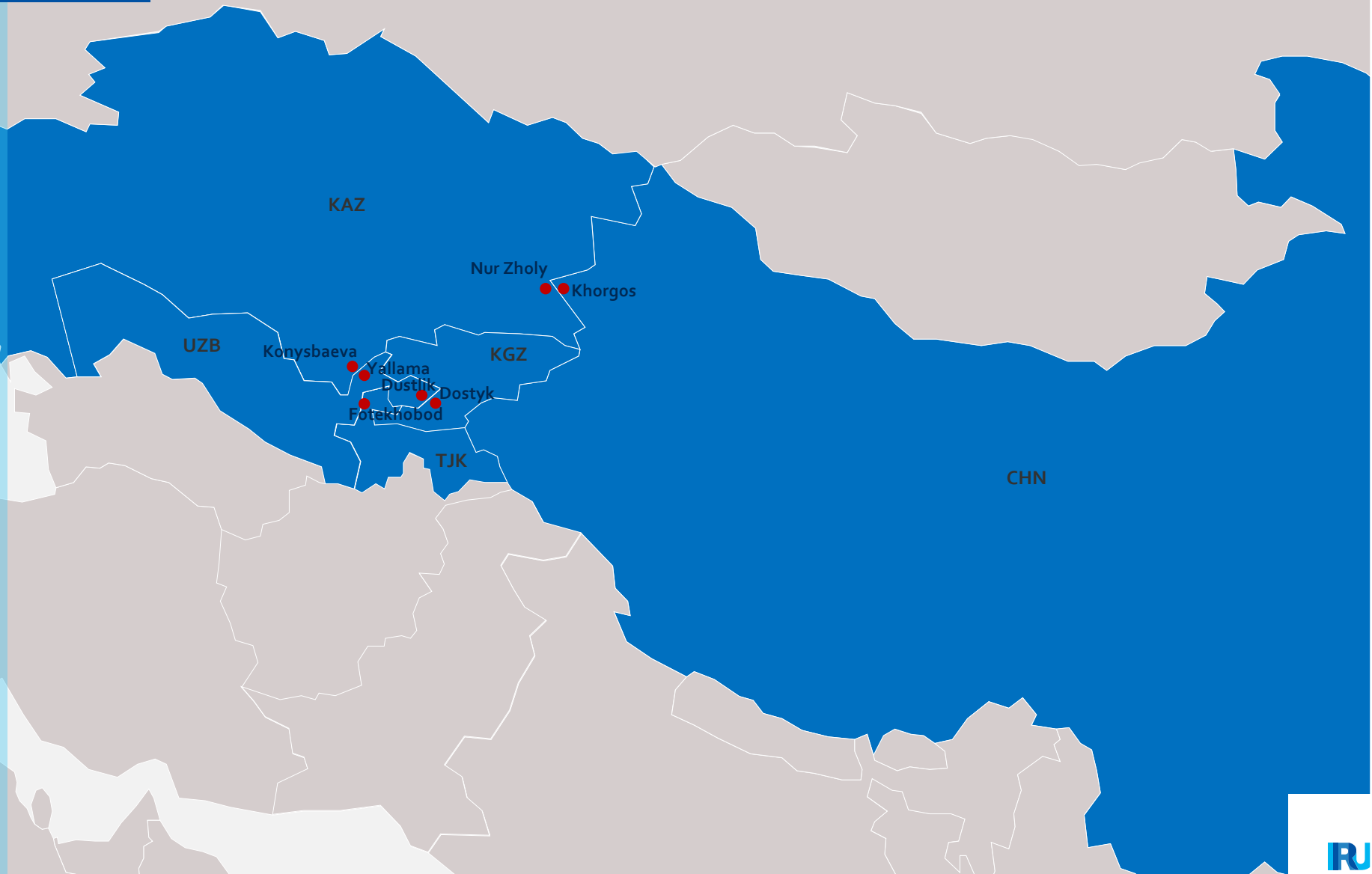


to speed up traffic flows
