




Azerbaijan on the CAREC corridors


- Azerbaijan is located on the 2nd corridor of CAREC
- 🔯 Steady growth in transit freight volume over Azerbaijan



- Improvement for international infrastructure and efficiency is still needed through tackling bottlenecks on transit corridor and increasing its efficiency and reliability:
 - operational improvement
 - reduction of time



In order to capture the opportunity, competitiveness of Azerbaijan route can be increased via operational improvements and reduction of time in transit



Identified bottlenecks

- High rolling stock utilization of Kazakhstan railways, which may require further investment
- Unexpected maritime delays due to weather conditions in Caspian
- Longer than expected transshipment process at both Aktau and Alat ports due to low coordination across operators
- Lack of scheduled block trains increasing required transit duration Mountainous region in Georgia
- Limited capacity of BTK with slower than usual transshipment process with coordination and train supply issues
- Limited capacity of Poti and Batumi ports
- Lack of coordination between customs authorities

1 Custom point

Construction works at the "Khanoba" customs point are still underway.

2 Bridge

Construction of a highway bridge and a pedestrian crossing over the Astarachay river

3 Astara terminal

Although the construction work of the Astara terminals module continues, several modules of the terminal are already ready

- 4 Development in the Port of Baku will increase total throughput capacity to 25M T of general cargo from 10M T.
- 5 Logistic centers are planned to be built in Azerbaijan


airports in the recently liberated areas to be built:

Opportunities around Zaqatala, Ganja, Gabala, Lankaran airports to more effectively leverage them (specifically for tourism)

After commencement of Zangazur route, the volume of transit will increase by ~5-8 million tons/year.

Planned route of Zangezur as part of Middle Corridor



... in the context of international initiatives

- has clear potential to become a faster and shorter transit passage for Europe and Asian countries
- can create additional opportunities for increasing the potential of the Middle Corridor in the East-West direction within the framework of China's One Belt One Road initiative
- may enable the diversification of routes and trade routes
- despite the fact that China's transportation to the West is dominated by the sea route (nearly 98%), in terms of diversification, it pays special attention to transportation through Russia* and the Middle Corridor
- will connect Azerbaijani railways with Iranian railways, which will act as a link between Russian railways and Iranian railways. As a result, a direct railway connection will be created along the route of India-Iran's Persian Gulf ports-Azerbaijan-Russian Federation-Northern Europe route
