
Highlights of the CAREC Senior Officials' Meeting


- Review of the 2013 CPMM report
 - marginal improvement in clearing time at BCPs
 - speed in traveling along CAREC corridors slightly deteriorated
 - high costs at BCPs and traveling along corridors persist
 - suggestions for refinements and improvements of CPMM
- Support to CAREC Trade Facilitation
 - customs cooperation: risk management, coordinated border management at country level, accession to Revised Kyoto Convention, and customs modernization
 - Integrated trade facilitation: regional project to improve sanitary and phytosanitary (SPS) measures for trade, regional transit issues, regional improvement of border services


- Economic Corridor Development study to focus on the Almaty-Bishkek cross border corridor
