In February 2015, Japan-Mongolia Economic Partnership Agreement was signed. It includes a chapter on Electronic commerce.

- Focuses on Digital products /computer programs, text, videos, images, sound recordings that are digitally encoded/;
- Each party will not impose customs duties on electronic transmissions;
