# Background to the strategy

- United Nations Decade of Action for Road Safety 2011-2020
- Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to improve road safety
- Global Plan for the Decade of Action for Road Safety 2011-2020 provides a framework for national and regional strategies:
  - “safe system” approach to road safety
  - five pillars for organizing activities



# CAREC Ministerial Commitment to Road Safety

14th Ministerial Conference in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, in September 2015 endorsed a joint commitment to road safety:

- Collective action to improve road safety – cooperation and consistency in approach across CAREC
- Adopting international good practice in road safety (“safe systems” approach) and building on existing efforts
- Region-wide approaches supported by joint capacity building and knowledge sharing activities
- CAREC partnership and multilateral development partners is an effective platform from which to improve road safety

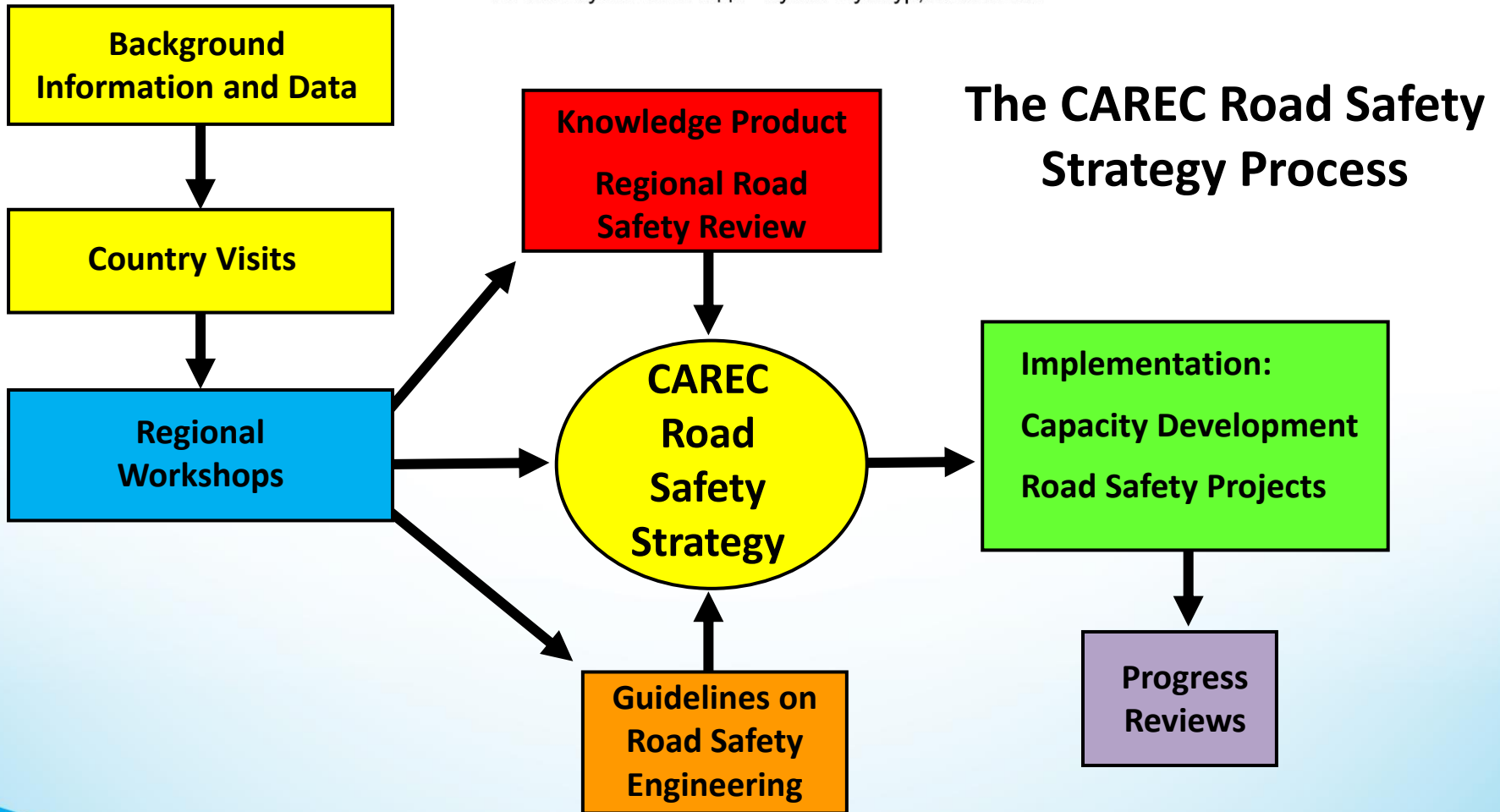

# Progress to date

- First CAREC Road Safety Workshop held 18-19 April 2016:
  - Regional SWOT analysis
  - Vision for the strategy
  - Draft strategy
- Outcomes of the Workshop were approved at 15<sup>th</sup> TSCC Meeting
- Outputs were circulated to CAREC countries for comments
- Draft Strategy positively reviewed at Senior Officials Meeting held 19/20 July in Islamabad
- SOM approved further processing with expectations that Road Safety Strategy will be approved as part of the 2016 CAREC program



# Key Objectives of Second CAREC Road Safety Workshop, 16 to 18 August, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

- 3 primary objectives of the workshop:
  1. Agree suitable road safety target(s)
  2. Agree Action Plan to support the Strategy
  3. Agree the results based monitoring framework

- Discussion at National Focal Point Meeting 20 September 2016
- Receive any outstanding comments by 22 September 2016
- Circulate final draft by 4 October 2016
- Consideration at year-end SOM and Ministerial Conference 25/26 October 2016 in Islamabad
