




Commodity Prices (Index, June 2011=100)













CAREC's growth is stabilizing



Projection 2016 (Real GDP growth)




Higher fiscal deficits and nominal depreciations helped avoid deeper recessions ...

Depreciation vs. USD since June-2014


(Annual growth, percent, USD per unit national currency)

Non-Performing Loans


(In Percent of Total Loans)


CAREC's medium-term growth outlook is weak, both historically and relative to Asian peer countries
