

Economic and Financial Stability

- Regional learning and knowledge sharing on economic and financial stability, with focus on sector linkages and policy responses
- Financial and monetary cooperation
 - ✓ Information exchange forum among central banks & capital market regulators
 - ✓ Developing common approaches to international standards, leading to eventual cross-listing of securities

Trade Facilitation and Trade Policy

- Support for WTO TFA
- Single window and coordinated border management
- Mitigating non-tariff barriers: SPS&TBT
- Trade in services (e-commerce, etc.)
- Regional trade agreements

Investment

- A sound investment climate and stronger cross-border investment
- Economic diversification through increased private sector participation

Economic Corridors

- Regional and global value chains
- Complete the ABEC
- Lesson learning for possible extension of corridor development
- Supportive urban policies and programs

Tourism

- Promoting people-to-people contact
- Community-based, eco-, and urban-tourism
- Harmonization of visa regimes



Infrastructure and Economic Connectivity Cluster

Transport

- Multimodal and sustainable transportation systems
- Railway management and improving railway infrastructure
- Liberalization of civil aviation and open-skies agreements
- Dry ports to facilitate transport in landlocked countries
- Road safety and road asset management

Energy

- Clean & renewable energy by leapfrogging technologies to curb carbon emission; consider emission trading systems
- Integrating energy markets through TUTAP, TAP and TAPI



Agriculture

- Food safety
- Agricultural value chains
- Regional knowledge sharing on adaptation and agricultural technologies
- Conservation of bio-resources through cross-country ecosystem

Water Management

- Address water scarcity, water productivity, water efficiency, and transboundary water resource management
- "Early harvest" areas could include irrigation efficiency, flood risk management and water contamination reduction



Education

- Integrated labor market information system development
- Cross-border higher education and TVET program offerings
- Mutual recognition of skills and qualifications

Health

- Communicable diseases control and pandemic risk management
- Health-related surveillance systems
- Cross-learning in prevention and treatment protocols


Results Framework
