CAREC Transport Strategy 2030


- Adopted in 2019 by the CAREC Ministerial Conference
- Strongly aligned with CAREC strategic goals of improving connectivity and sustainability of transport systems and infrastructure
- High emphasis on quality and sustainability of transport projects rather than on volume and scale of infrastructure development and financing
- Knowledge products are demand driven and serve as high-level decision support tools for the CAREC DMCs
- Performance reporting became more CAREC Corridor and country specific, complemented by analytical reports to support decision making both at the regional and national levels.


Strategic focus by pillar


- Cross-border Transport and Logistics
 - Supporting modern and risk-based land border crossing and ports procedures, technologies and infrastructure to increase speed and reduce cost of travel along the CAREC corridors
- Road Assets Management Systems (RAMS)
 - Promoting and institutionalizing RAMS to increase road asset life cycle and reduce total cost of infrastructure vis-à-vis increasing quality of road network.
- Road Safety Management
 - The pillar is guided by its own strategy. Road Safety Engineering received a lot of development over he last few years. Other components of Road Safety Management are receiving more attention in the coming years.
- Railways
 - Guided by its own strategy to develop railways as a mode of choice user-friendly, efficient, reliable, environmentally-friendly.
- Aviation
 - Significantly impacted by COVID-19. Based on the CAREC study, current focus is on the LCC development and facilitation of the aviation cargo operations.





Suggested key decisions for 20th TSCC meeting

- Middle Corridor was discussed in 2022 when ocean freight rates were still above the normal level. Since ocean rates came back to normal, more attention will be given to long-term investment decisions. Several CAREC development partners and other international organizations carry out practical assessments of the corridor. CAREC Transport Secretariat will coordinate will various analytical teams to bring best recommendations to the CAREC Developing Member Countries
- Paris Agreement Alignment is an important theme for all development banks.
 CAREC Transport Secretariat suggests that the theme becomes an integral part of the program, being reflected in it strategic documents and action plans.
- Development of analytical reports and manuals received sufficient attention in recent years. During the pre-COVID years, many training activities were initiated but were put on hold during the pandemic period. Training and Capacity development activities will receive revived attention. More country-focused studies under all pillars will be carried out.
