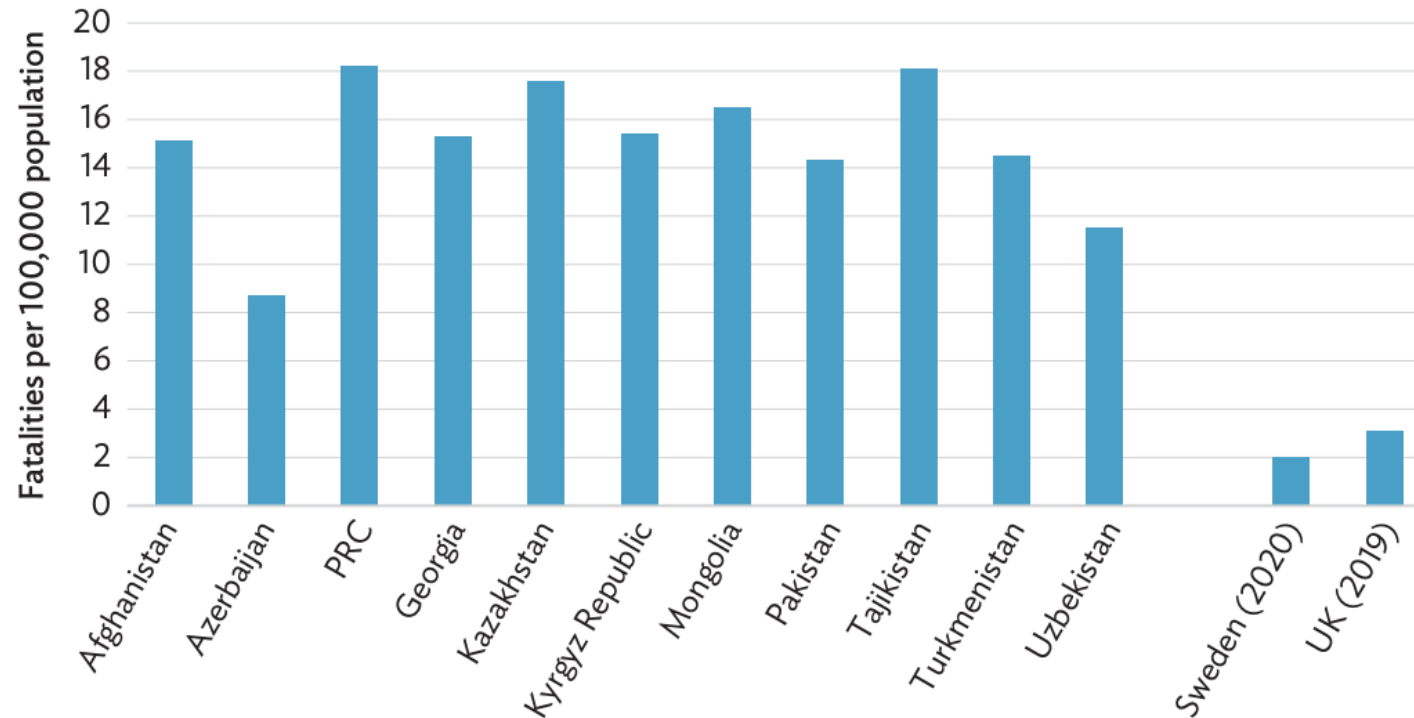

Figure: Estimated Road Traffic Fatalities in 2016 per 100,000 Population in CAREC Countries, Sweden, and the United Kingdom

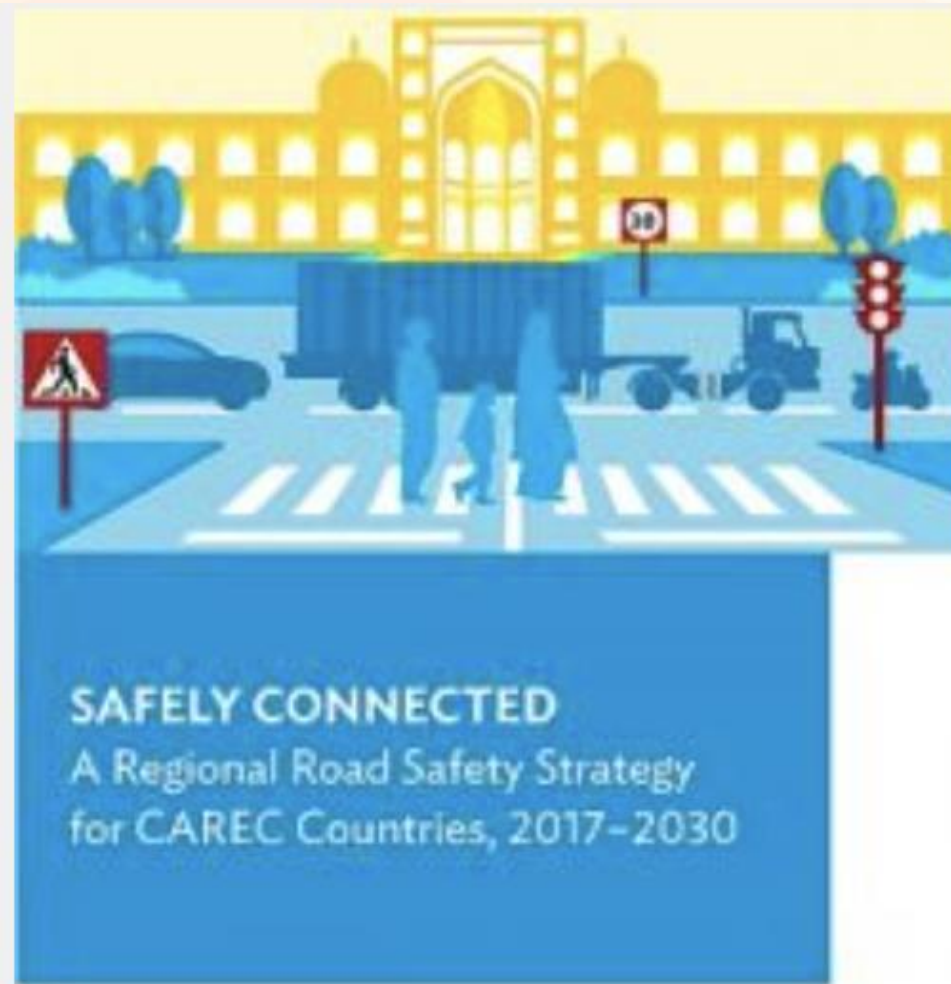

CAREC ROAD SAFETY STRATEGY 2017-2030

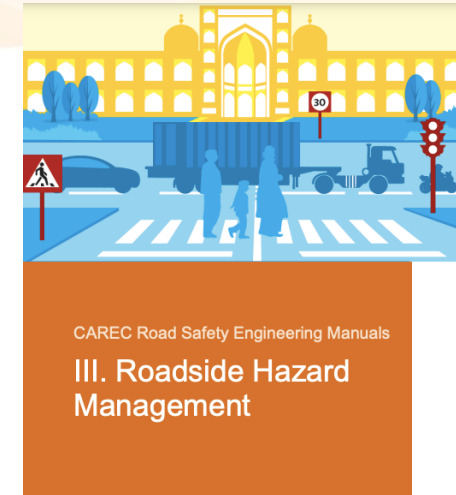

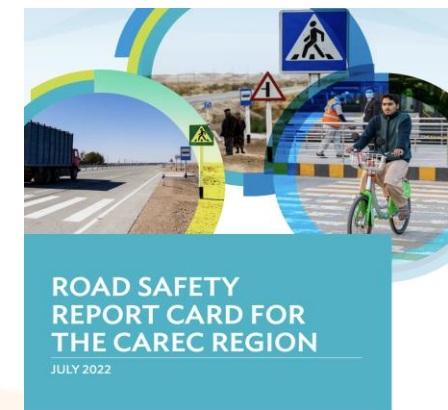
- Builds on KSTA for Enhancing Road Safety for Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation Member Countries which was implemented from December 2014 to May 2019.

CAREC REGION ROAD CRASH DATA REVIEW AND DEVELOP WEB BASED DASHBOARD TO REPORT ACCIDENTS

- Assess road crash data management practices for CAREC country and develop guidance in an effort to improve crash data management
- Move towards greater harmonization of crash data across the region.
- Country reviews including of crash data management by CAREC member countries, include assessment for collection at the national level and recommendations for improvement
- Propose a standard collision classification system for the CAREC region based on systems used in best practice countries and considering CAREC region specific conditions
- Develop a web-based dashboard to report accidents through existing organizational resources available in each province.
- In-person training on improvement to crash data management

NEXT STEPS

- Conduct several national trainings on different elements of road safety in the HWW workshop

- More knowledge products on different road safety topics
- Explore pilot projects focusing on enhancing road safety like speed management, school zone safety programs in the CAREC region
