


Major economies around the world recovered strongly in 2017



In 2017, the global tourism growth rate has exceeded the economic growth rate for the seventh consecutive year and is the best year for tourism development in recent years.

Among them, China's tourism industry has contributed a total of 8.77 trillion yuan, contributing 11.04% to the national economy and 10.28% to the society.

In 2017, global tourism contributed 8.3 trillion US dollars of GDP, accounting for 10.4% of global GDP.








Border Tourism Pilot Zone and cross-border cooperation



In November 2015, China and Vietnam signed the Cooperation Agreement on Protection and Development of Detian Waterfall Tourism Resources, which is China's first cross-border tourism cooperation zone.

In April 2018, the State Council agreed to establish Manzhouli and Fangchenggang Border Tourism Experimental Zone the Manzhouli in Inner Mongolia and Guangxi province. This is the first batch of border tourism pilot zone established in China.


