


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CAREC Integrated Trade Agenda 2030

Pillars and Institutional Structure





CAREC = Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation, CFCFA = CAREC Federation of Carrier and Forwarder Associations, NCTF = national committee on trade facilitation, SPS = sanitary and phytosanitary, WCO = World Customs Organization, WTO = World Trade Organization.

Regional Trade Group (RTG) is the lead consultative and coordinating body for CAREC trade work as embodied in CITA 2030 and the Rolling Strategic Action Plan

Pillar 1: Trade expansion from increased market access

- WTO TFA implementation at 45.5% (average) for mandatory provisions; all CAREC made progress in UNTF Survey 2021
- WTO accession of AZE and UZB; TKM (WTO observer) launched seminar series in December 2020
- In February 2021, UN Framework Agreement on Facilitation of Cross-Border Paperless Trade entered into force: AZE and the PRC are members, others preparing to join
- Implementation of Regional Improvement of Border Services (RIBS); Regional Upgrade of SPS measures for Trade projects
- Mapping of technical regulations, standards and conformity assessment procedures underway



Pillar 2: Greater diversification

- Parallel investments to develop cross-border economic zone between the PRC and MON in corridor 4
- In July 2021, MON joined AZE as contracting parties to the UN Convention on the Use of Electronic Communications in International Contracts
- Digital trade initiatives (e-customs systems, e-SPS certificates, CATS/ICE)
- Assessment of regulatory framework and infrastructure development of e-commerce in CAREC
- Study on advancing economic diversification in CAREC through services sector development



Pillar 3: Stronger institutions for trade

- Capacity building and research on potential CAREC free trade agreement
- Study on customs readiness and challenges on cross-border e-commerce consignments
- Reviving the SPS national working groups
- Creating synergy between CAREC trade and other sectors' initiatives to facilitate safe movement of people and goods while increasing resilience to cross-border threats (One-Health approach)




