- Improve the new Eurasian land bridge international road transport corridor



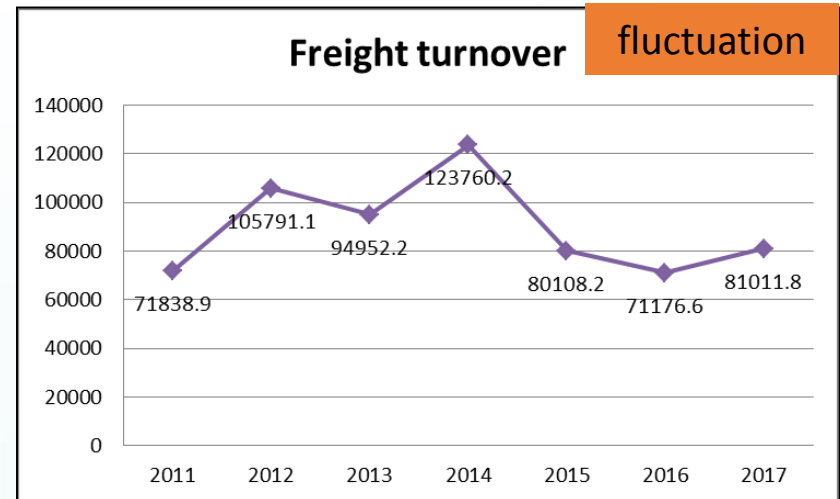
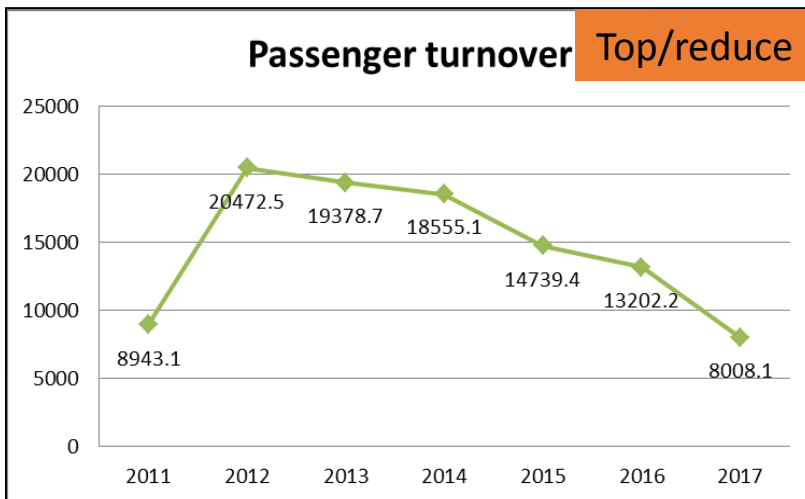
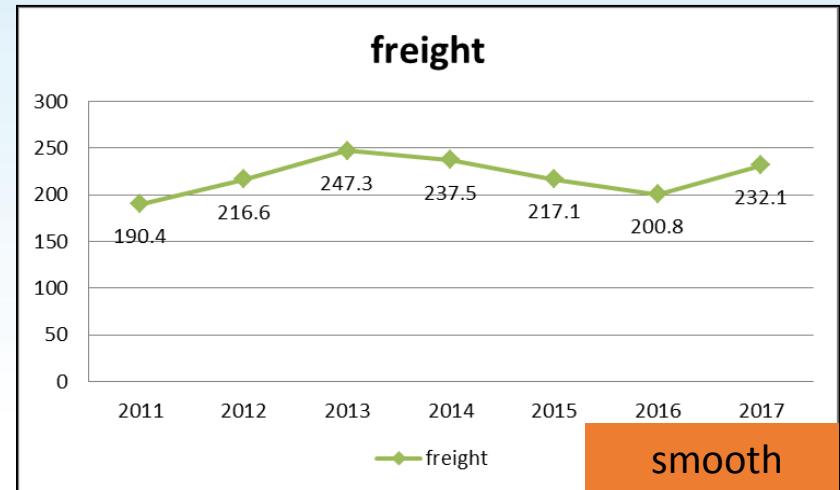
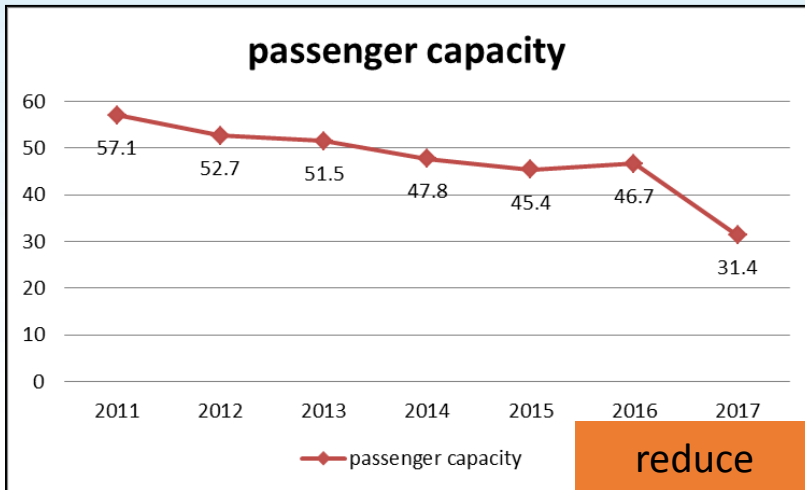

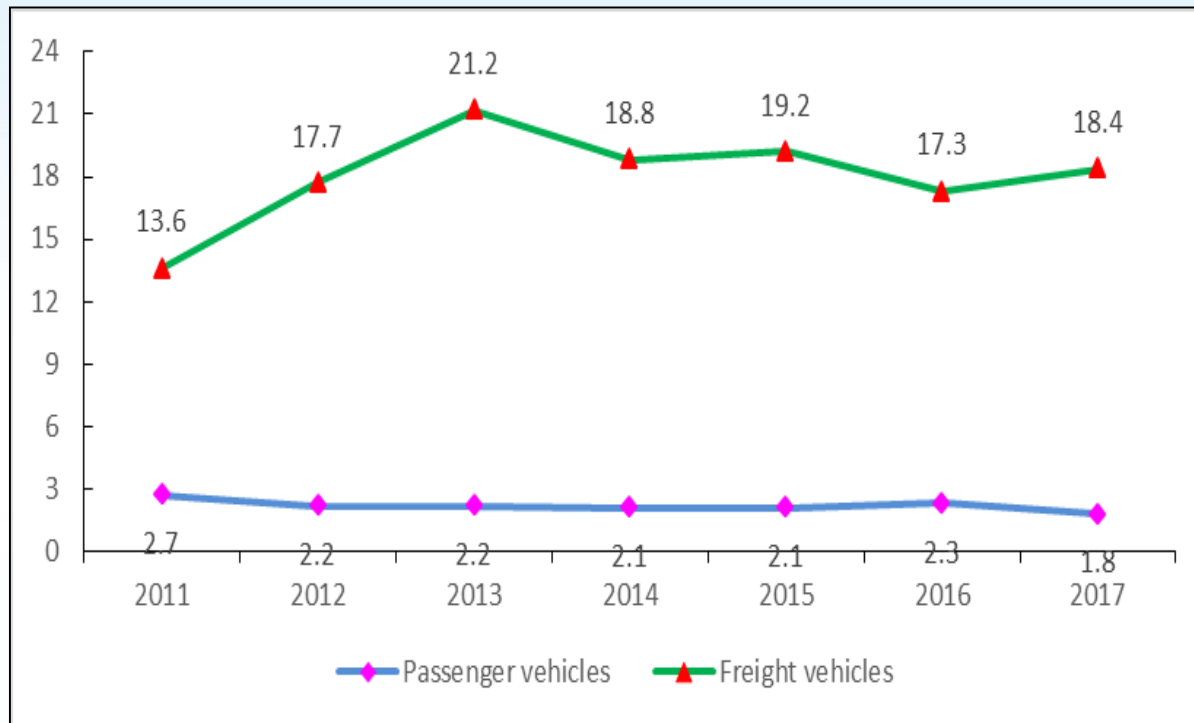

Intergovernmental Agreement of the SCO Member States on the Facilitation of International Road Transport

September 12, 2014, **China, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russia, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan**

- Improve international road transport, customs formality, non-physical barriers, transport costs and economic and trade cooperation
- facilitate international road transport, promote regional connectivity and promote economic and trade cooperation

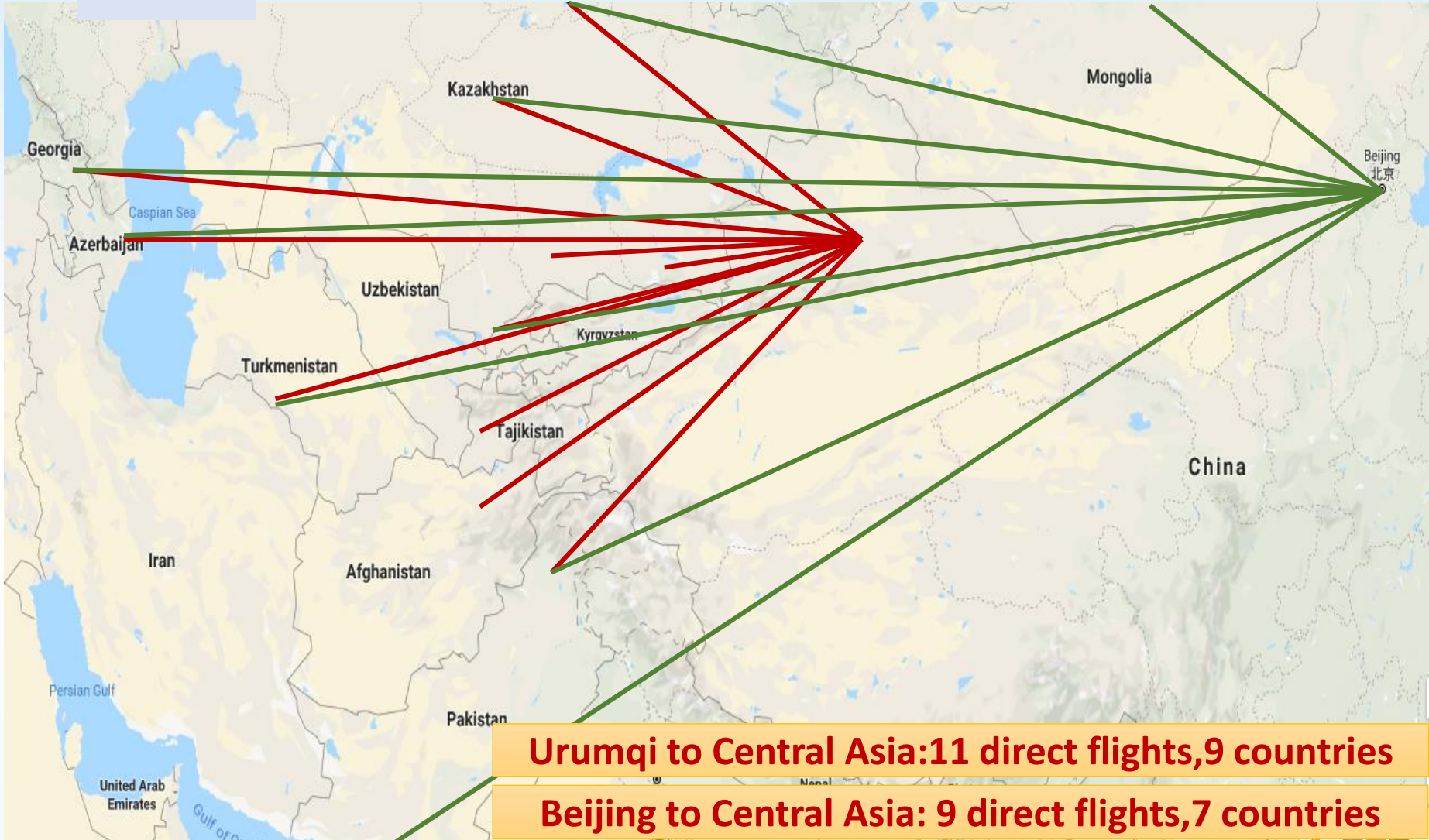

Implementation Progress of the TTFS 2020 projects

- April 2017, Railway authorities of the Belt and Road countries including China, Belarus, Germany, Kazakhstan, Mongolia, Poland and Russia, have signed an agreement to deepen cooperation on China-Europe freight rail services
- Promote the cooperation of **railway mail service** projects between countries along **China Railway Express**

National Priority Actions for 2020 to 2030

Agreement

To be signed in April 2019 :

(1) Agreement between the government of the People's Republic of China and the government of the Republic of Belarus on international road transport

- China has **no previous** agreements with Belarus
- this agreement will promote the convenience of the international road transport



National Priority Actions for 2020 to 2030

Agreement

(2) Agreement between the government of the People's Republic of China and the government of Georgia on international road transport of passengers and goods

- **no previous** agreements
- accelerate the economic and trade cooperation
- develop the transportation of passengers and goods



National Priority Actions for 2020 to 2030

Agreement

(3) Protocol between the government of the People's Republic of China and the government of Nepal on the **implementation** of the *agreement on transit transport between the government of the People's Republic of China and the government of Nepal*

- On March 21, 2016, the two countries **signed** the *agreement on transit transport between the government of the People's Republic of China and the government of*



Post

National Priority Actions for 2020 to 2030

- the Cooperation agreement signed by China and the UPU(Universal Postal Union), improve the **UPU** rules for international railway mail transport, provide training and guidance for member states along the routes to exchange railway mail.
- China will continue to support the import and export transportation of postal test in **Chongqing, Yiwu, Dongguan and Zhengzhou**
