2. Counterpart financing

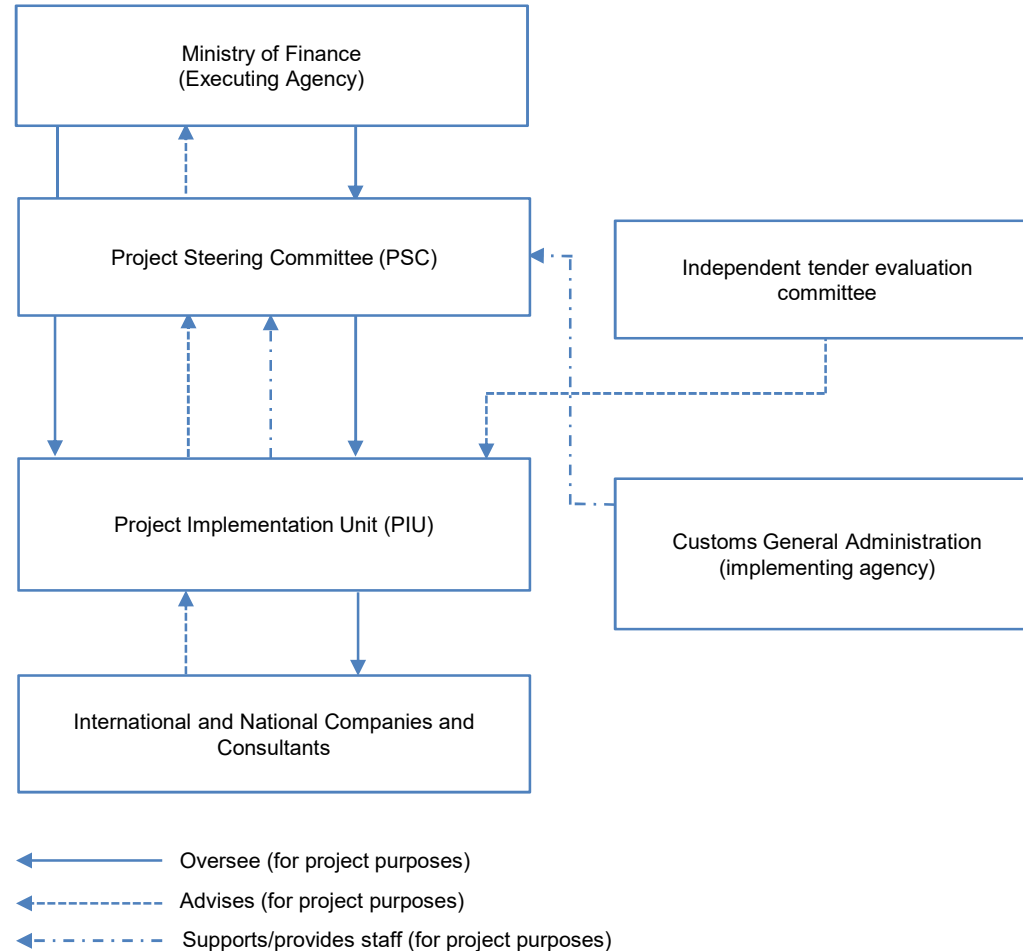
from the Government of Mongolia amounting to \$2.07 million equivalent (inkind)

- **Output 2:** Communication infrastructure for the Customs automated information system (CAIS) is strengthened and upgraded.
- **Output 3:** Preparatory work for single window is undertaken.

Two: Accession to RKC Convention

- The RKC became effective for Mongolia since 1 October 2006
- National customs legislation (Customs Law and Custom Tariff and Duty Law) were drafted in line with the RKC, approved by the Mongolian Parliament and entered into force since 1 July 2008
- Current ongoing revision inline with RKC



Three: JCC case study

Achievement since 14th CCC:

- Testing on electronic exchange of manifest data between HQs of Mongolia and PRC

Challenge:

- Pending activities due to organizational restructuring
