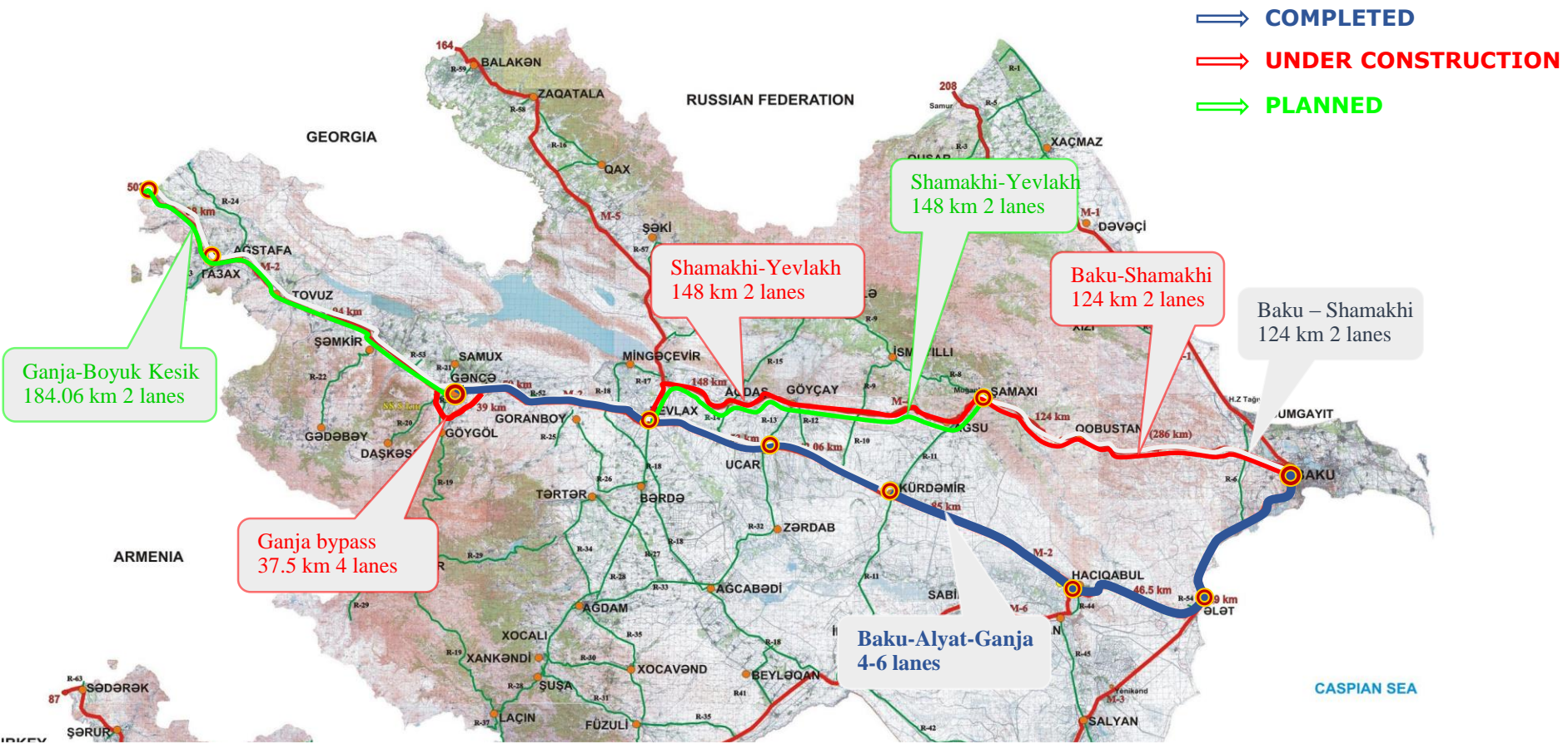


Implementation Progress of the TTFS 2020 hardware projects

Road	Hajigabul-Yevlakh-Ganja (additional 2 lanes)	Completed
Road	Ganja-Gazakh-Georgia Border (additional 2 lanes)	Under design period
Road	Baku-Shamakhi-Yevlakh (2 lanes)	Under construction and rehabilitation
Railway	Rehabilitation of 503 km railway in Baku–Boyuk Kesik segment	Completed
Port and Shipping	Construction of new Baku International Trade Sea Port	Ferry terminal commissioned as part of first stage. RO-RO terminal was inaugurated on January, 2018. Other works within first stage planned to be completed by May, 2018.

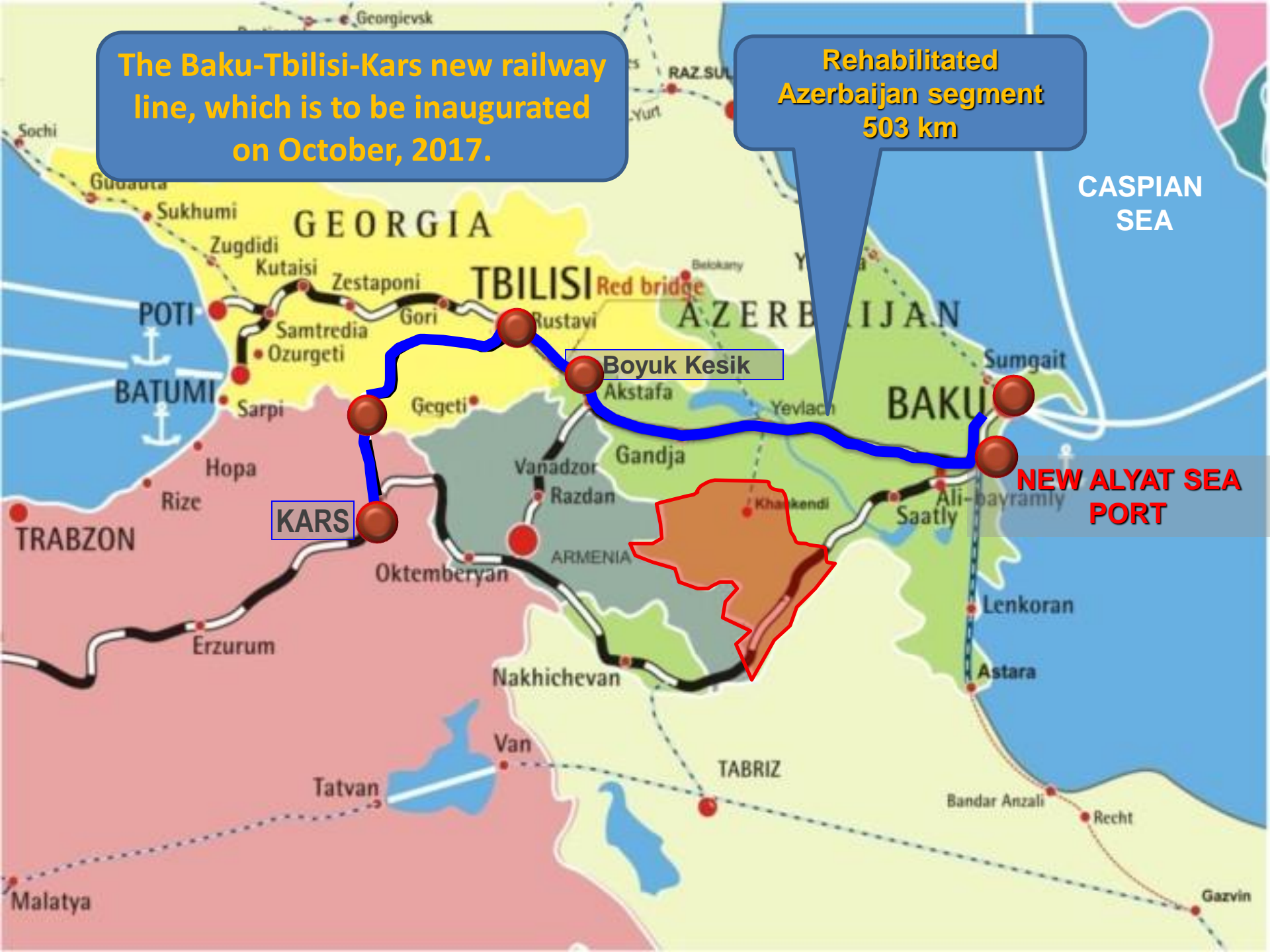

Rehabilitated Azerbaijan segment 503 km



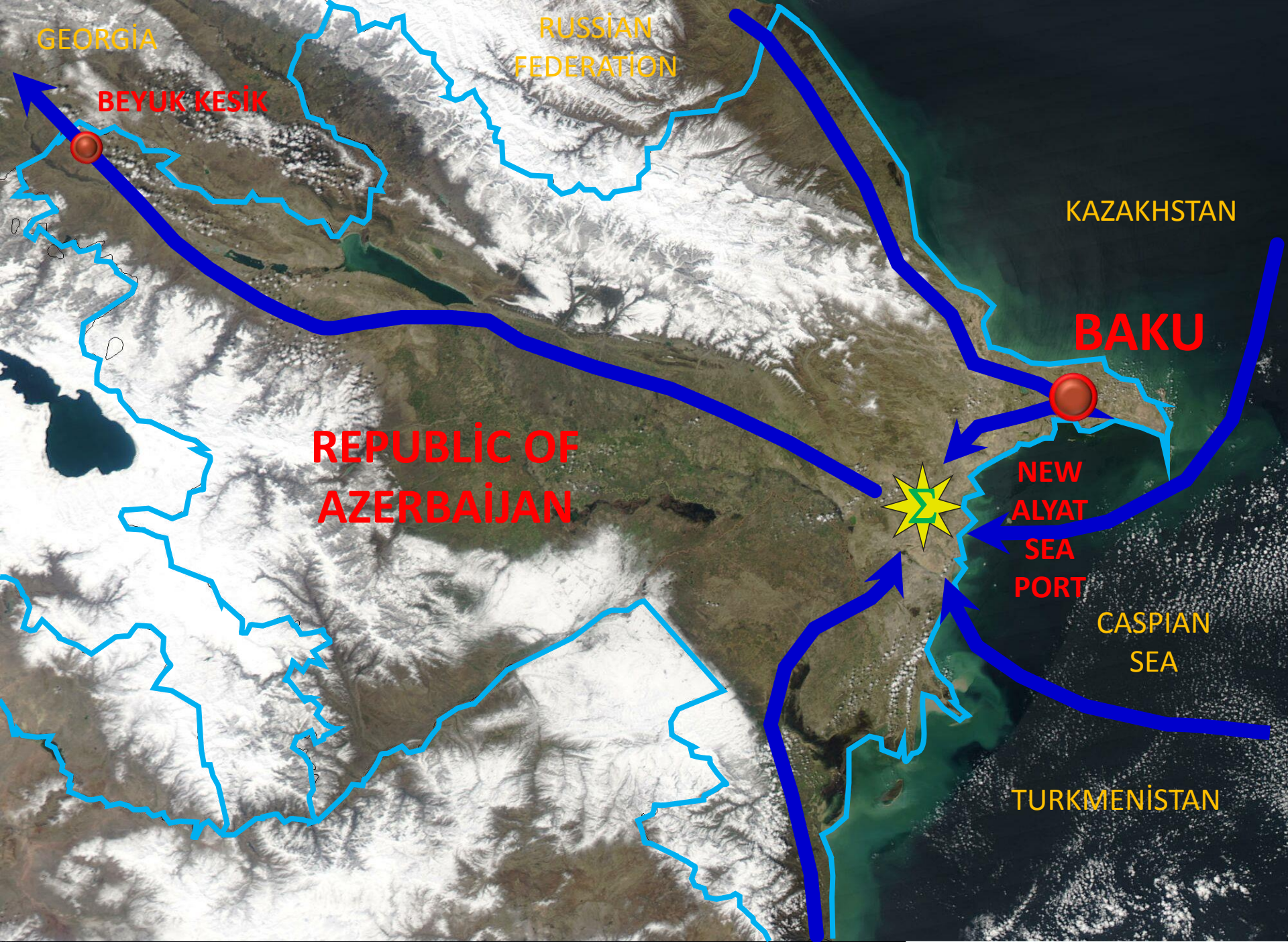
Astara (Azerbaijan) – Astara (Iran) Railway link

Other National Priority Actions, planned for 2018-2020 and beyond 2020

- Completion of road projects excepted Ganja-Gazakh-Georgian Border road;
- Completion of construction works for transition of power supply system (from direct current to alternating one), catenaries network renewal or rebuilding works and improvements in communication and signaling systems of 503 km railways in Baku-Beyuk Khasik segment;
- Continuation of electrification and rehabilitation of railways all over the country;
- Acquisition of 50 locomotives and 1600 new wagons till the end of 2018;
- Decision about starting of construction works within the second stage of Baku International Trade Sea Port project will be made in accordance with the market demand.
