CAREC WTO Accession Knowledge Sharing Program: Managing WTO Accession Process - Strategies, Challenges and Practices

(24 – 26 July 2012, Shanghai, People's Republic of China)

The main objective of the seminar is to help trade officials in non-WTO CAREC countries to better perform their key functions before, during and after the accession process in areas such as identification of goals; assessment of options based on model simulations; formulation of negotiating strategies and fall-back options; and management of the negotiating team and national committee. The seminar would also build or strengthen networking among the trade officials and facilitate sustainable peer-to-peer knowledge sharing and mentoring.

The seminar will be conducted in interactive format to encourage active participation and discussion. Officials from the WTO CAREC countries would present their experiences and lessons learned about selected topics. The non-WTO CAREC countries would have the opportunity to pose questions about how to manage specific issues during their own accession process. The WTO countries will provide advice from their experiences.

Towards end of the seminar, officials from non-WTO countries would be required to present individual country information papers (approximately 3-5 pages) which contain a summary of the knowledge acquired during the seminar, particularly on how it relates to their country's situation, and recommendations for how their country can address particular accession issues. The participants would be expected to submit the information papers to their respective trade ministries, along with holding briefing sessions for their colleagues to disseminate knowledge.
