- 5. Strengthening Effectiveness and Results-Based Orientation: what additional steps can be taken (i) to strengthen the operational effectiveness of the Overall Institutional Framework (OIF); and (ii) to focus CAREC activities more on expected results.
- 6. Promoting Private Sector Participation: whether a "private sector strategy" note should be prepared for the 4th Ministerial Conference that identifies options for engaging the private sector in CAREC, including how private sector participation may be accommodated within the framework of the OIF.
