- (ii) Is the CAREC Gender Strategy 2030, including its vision, mission and objectives statements, and strategic entry points for each of the five CAREC operational clusters, aligned with national gender priorities and strategies? Are there any other important strategic areas that should be included or dropped?
- (iii) Do the proposed institutional arrangements provide an effective and flexible mechanism to ensure coordination between CAREC countries and rest of stakeholders to mainstream gender in their operations? Are there any other elements that should be included to strengthen institutional efficiency and coordination going forward?
- (iv) Are the proposed outputs in the results framework (section VI) adequate for monitoring and evaluating the implementation progress of the gender strategy 2030?
