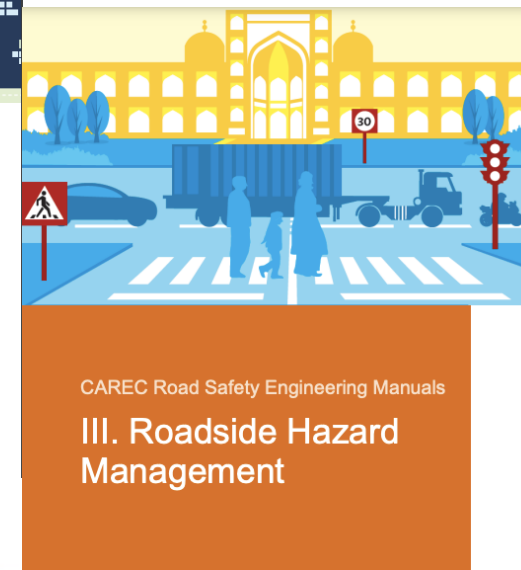
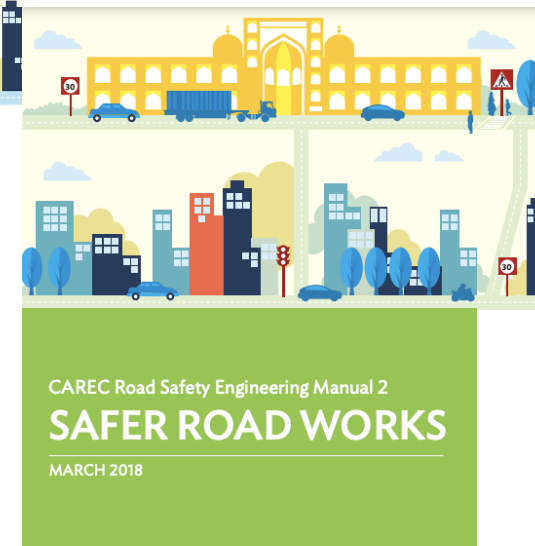
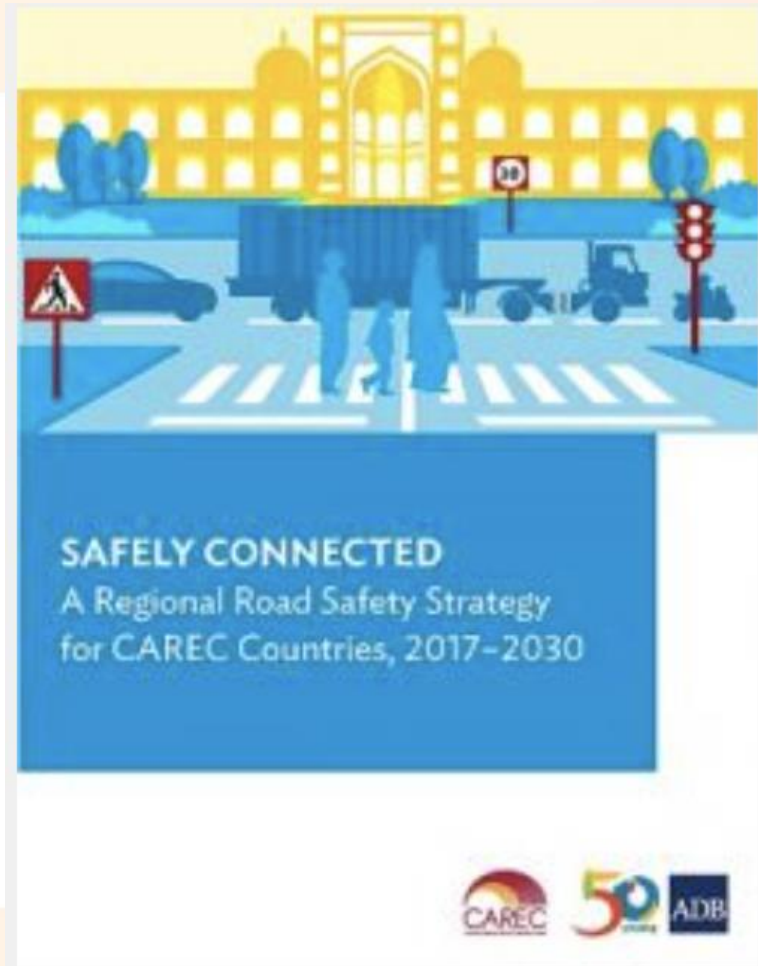
Knowledge Support Technical Assistances

- Enhancing Road Safety for CAREC Member Countries : 2014 to 2018, \$3.0 million
- Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation: Knowledge Sharing and Services in Transport and Transport Facilitation: 2014 to 2018, \$3.05 million
- Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation: Knowledge Sharing and Services in Transport and Transport Facilitation (Phase 2): 2019 to 2022, \$1.5 million
- Enhancing Road Safety for CAREC Member Countries (Phase 2): 2020 to 2024, \$1.5 million

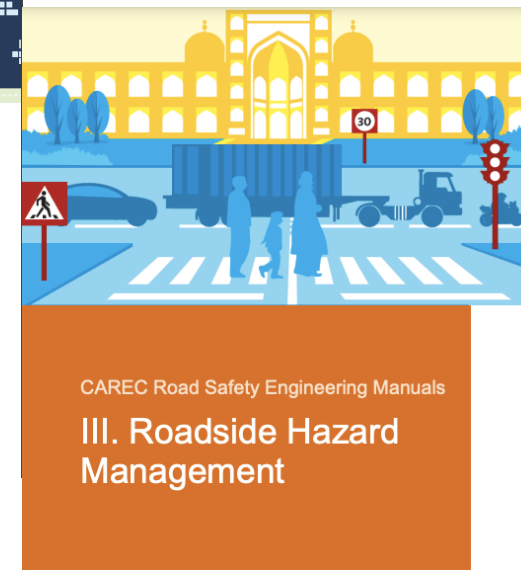
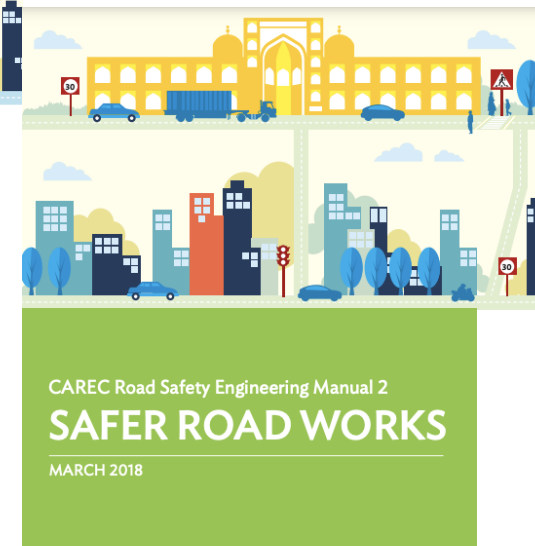
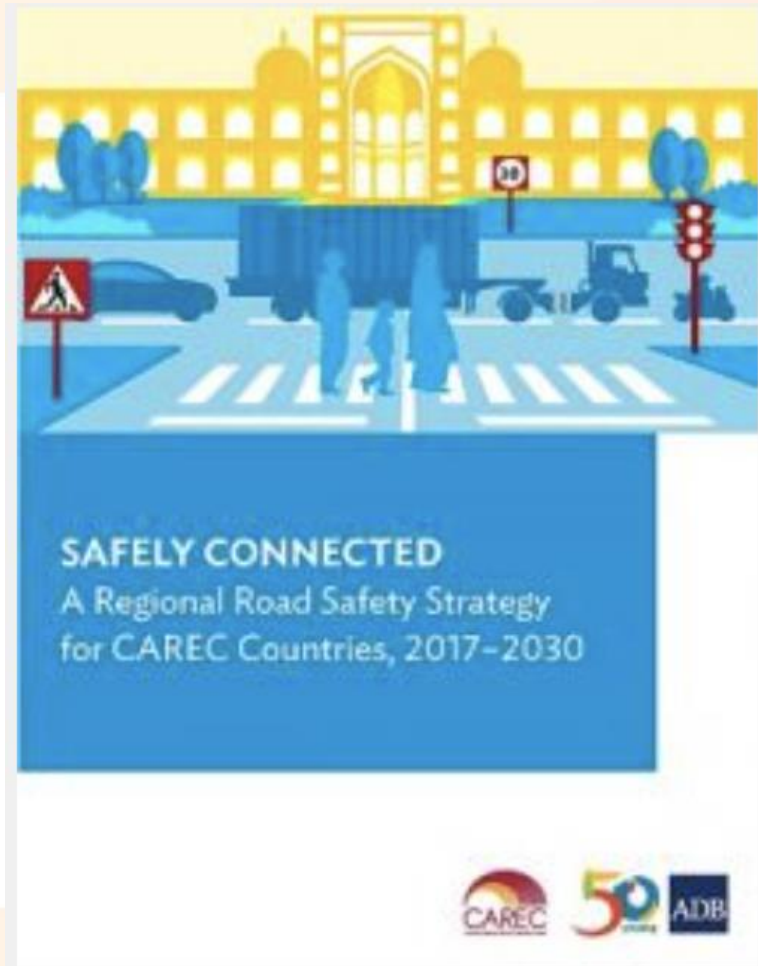
Enhancing Road Safety for Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation Member Countries (Phase 2)

- Budget= \$1.5 million
- Builds on KSTA for Enhancing Road Safety for Central Asia Regional Economic Cooperation Member Countries which was implemented from December 2014 to May 2019.
- Equip CAREC member countries with the necessary skills and knowledge products
- Facilitate regional policy dialogue, knowledge sharing, and a coordinated approach to common road safety challenges.
- Filling the gaps identified during implementation of CAREC road safety strategy 2017-2030 and support CAREC countries further.

Trainings/Workshops conducted

Several national and regional trainings/workshops on topics:

- road safety data systems and research
- road safety engineering
- road safety education and awareness
- road safety enforcement

Planned activities

- New RSE Manuals under preparation: Speed Management, Blackspot Investigation
- Action plan/operational plan for a road safety engineering unit
- Trainings on topics relating to road safety engineering, road safety management like road safety audit, road safety engineering principles, crash data investigation and analysis, knowledge of specific and general deterrence principles.
- Standard crash reporting system based on a minimum set of quality indicators and centralized road crash database.
- Mobile application to record, report and analyze road crash data.
