




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# **CAREC Digital Strategy Steering Committee: Proposed Evolution**


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# **CAREC Startup Map**

## **CAREC Innovation Network (CIN)**

- 60 Active members representing the Startup Ecosystem Support Organizations from the CAREC countries.
- 5 CIN Members' Workshop (virtual events)
- 250+ participants have attended the capacity-building sessions











#### **CAREC Innovation Decoded (CID)**

- CID aims to provide South-South **learning** and **networking** opportunities for the startup ecosystem players in the CAREC region.
- The first series of workshops focused on China's startup ecosystem. Four online sessions were organized to provide in-depth insights into the development of China's startup ecosystem and digital economy.







## **CAREC University Innovation Exchange Program (UIEP)**

- A dynamic 2-week program across 4 countries in the CAREC region.
- 22 young entrepreneurs (12 startup teams),
   4 university coordinators
- 18 training sessions for students
- 2 roundtable discussions for coordinators with key stakeholders. 40+ experts and mentors connected
- 14 site visits to startup ecosystem stakeholders












## **CAREC Regional Startup Bootcamp (RSBC)**

- A Vigorus 2-week program across 3 countries in the CAREC region.
- 8 startup teams 3 incubation/ accelerator coordinators
- 10 training sessions for participants
- 3 roundtable discussions for coordinators with key stakeholders
- 15+ experts and mentors connected
- 14+ site visits to startup ecosystem stakeholders







#### **CAREC University Open Innovation Challenge**

- 168 teams, 580 students across 10 CAREC countries.
- 8 weeks of training, marketing research, brainstorming, validating ideas, developing business models, value proposition, mentorship, mock pitching, demo day, etc.
- 10 finalist teams for demo day; 4 winning teams received up to USD 5000 cash prize.







#### Workshop and Korea Showcase: University as Enablers of Vibrant Startup Ecosystems

- 21 representatives from government and universities across Azerbaijan, Georgia, Kazakhstan, and Uzbekistan
- International Practice Sharing by 4 countries
- Site Visits to Soongsil University, Hannam
   University, Global Digital Innovation Network,
   Korea Development Institute, and Korea
   Advanced Institute of Science and Technology
- 4 thematic areas identified to support startup ecosystem: Commercialization, Curriculum, Incubation and Acceleration Program, Regulation











## **CAREC Ecosystem Health Check and Case Study Initiative**

- Evaluate and rank the health and potential of selected start-up ecosystems within the CAREC region.
- Focused on those ecosystems that are ranked within the top 500 globally.
- The objective is to provide a comprehensive analysis, leveraging the Global Start-up Ecosystem Index (GSEI) framework





## **CAREC Business Angel Network**

- Analysis of the existing Angel Networks covering the CAREC region and promoting a Regional focus.
- Start-up Deals Mapping & Share the information on our CAREC Start-up Map
- Regional Angel and Venture Financing Training for the (High Net Worth Individuals)
- Cross Border Angel Investment Summit In partnership with Axel's Venture Capital Builder Interactive Event <u>29<sup>th</sup></u> <u>September 2023</u>











#### **CAREC Business Angel Network**

#### **Current Challenges**

- •Lack of financial literacy and an understanding of the importance of investment diversification among high-networth individuals.
- ·Lack of follow-on investments.
- •Angel networks and VCs are increasingly investing less in startups at the idea stage, preferring more developed ventures.

#### **Key Strategies and Interventions**

- •Encourage cross-border investments and cooperation between angel networks and regional venture funds.
- •Improve venture legislation in CAREC countries.
- •Explore the possibility and cooperative potential for a CAREC Fund of Funds.
- •Increase the capacity of VC funds and angel network managers.
- •Boost the interest and capacity of high-net-worth individuals (HNWIs).











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## **CAREC Innovation Week and Digital Economy Tour (Hangzhou, PRC)**

- 54 CAREC delegates and 150 PRC delegates attended
- Several MoUs, collaboration agreements, and letters of intent were signed during the event.
- Participants explored the Global Digital Trade Expo and joined the Digital Economy Tours featuring Alibaba Group, Cainiao Smart Warehouse, Ant International, etc.
