# Establishing the Medium-Term Priority Projects for CAREC 2020 (MTPP) - Proposed Selection Parameter for Trade Facilitation

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#### 2011-2015 MTPP: Trade Facilitation

- Strategic Priorities/Selection Criteria
  - effective and efficient implementation of investment and TA programs identified by the TTFS and Action Plan, particularly those along the 6 CAREC transport and trade corridors;
  - institutional strengthening both at the national and regional level;
  - reaching out to all relevant stake-holders and maximization of synergies;
  - demonstrated strong country and regional ownership;
  - continued measurement and monitoring of results.



#### 2011-2015 MTPP: TF (cont.)

- Focus of Work for the MTPP
  - customs reforms, cooperation, and automation/modernization;
  - effective functioning of the NJCs (or similar organizations);
  - integrated trade facilitation (e.g., CPMM, TRS, SPS cooperation, strengthening of NJCs, SW development, RIBS project);
  - economic corridor development (trade logistics, private sector participation, and free economic zone development).

#### 2011-2015 MTPP: TF (cont.)

- Near-term (2011-12)
  - Work with R-PPTA consultants to prepare RIBS project
  - Empower NJCs to ensure smooth RIBS project implementation
  - Implementing investments and technical assistance programs under the TF MTPP
- Medium-term (2013-15)
  - Contribute to mid-term review of CAREC TTFS and Action Plan
  - Update sector strategy and action plan
  - Identify priority interventions for implementation during 2016-2020
- Responsibilities
  - <u>CCC</u>: Develop and review customs-related elements of the MTPP; monitor and evaluate ongoing projects
  - NJCs: Review the MTPP; make appropriate recommendations to the SOM/MC
  - <u>CFCFA</u>: Facilitating private sector participation in TF MTPP projects
  - TF institutions will work under the guidance of SOM and MC



## **Private Sector Participation**

- Mobilizing capital for trade facilitation key to success of the program
  - Trade logistics services and facilities
  - National single window interconnectivity and interoperability
  - Multi-modal transport
  - Trade finance
- Attracting private sector participants (from within and outside CAREC)
  - Access to market, land, and finance
  - Harmonize regulatory regimes regionally to facilitate market entry
  - Create competition: eliminate monopolies
