


Some Key Achievements of CAREC Countries

Improvement of customs services and border facilities

- national single window (NSW) launched in several CAREC countries
- coordinated border management and risk management adopted
- clearance time and steps reduced with unified customs manifest



Alignment with international agreements

- on-track implementation of WTO's Trade Facilitation Agreement for 8 members
- accession to WCO's Revised Kyoto Convention of 10 countries (2 in 2006)
- accession to the UN Framework Agreement on Facilitation of Cross-border Paperless Trade in Asia and the Pacific by 4 countries + 2 more under ratification



Enhanced institutional capacity

- organizational streamlining
- cross-learning and bilateral customs agreements (e.g., transit, cooperation at entry points, data sharing, mutual administrative assistance)





A CAREC Customs Transit Survey to assess alignment of countries with international best practices relating to transit regime operations

July 2022







Key Findings of Customs Transit Survey

- Closer collaboration between CAREC Customs authorities on transit data exchange
- Modernization of approaches to transit guarantees in several CAREC countries
- Increased simplification for transit movements
- Establishment/Integration of Electronic Advanced Data (EAD) into risk management processes
- Enhanced compliance for Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) programs
- More agreements/arrangements on transit cooperation



Proposed Next Steps on Customs Transit System (CTS)

- Review and update the Framework for a CAREC Customs Information Exchange (ICE) (September 2016) reflect the priority need for ICE/EAD connectivity development among CAREC customs authorities
- Each country develops, or updates, transit improvement plans (2023 to 2025) to align transit procedures with the international best practice detailed in the CTS
- Nominate new CAREC Advance Transit System (CATS) focal points and reconstitute technical working groups (Legal and Regulatory Group; Customs Control Facilitation Working Group, and ICT Working Group)
- Commence CATS 'test of concept' phase involving 3 countries in 2023

Mongolia: Resilient and Integrated Border Services for Safe and Fast Trade Project (2023)

Azerbaijan and Georgia: Scoping study for joint BCP (2022-2023)

Georgia: Scoping for use of artificial intelligence in import procedures (2022)

Mongolia: Development of online portal for verification of Certificate of Origin (2022)

Launch of **CATS/ICE** prototype (2023)

Joint activities with Korea Customs Service on cargo clearance, risk management, customs data model, and Authorized Economic Operators (AEO) scheme (2023-2024)
