CFCFA BUDGET

- Prepared in accordance with the proposed plan structure and consists of VI sections
- The expenses were estimated on the basis of prices in Almaty where the CFCFA secretariat will be located
- Can vary according to the volume of works, change of staff list, quantity of members, inflation, etc (minimum by 5% per year)

CFCFA EXPENSES ARE DIVIDED IN 4 CATEGORIES:

- \blacksquare salary **27,5%**,
- \blacksquare travel expenses (transport, accommodation, per diem) 45,3%;
- \blacksquare third party services -18,1%;
- \blacksquare contingencies -9,1%.
- * We propose to include 4 people in CFCFA Permanent Secretariat: secretary, 2 secretary assistants and accountant (additional discussion, see "Principles of Secretariat activity")
- * Salaries of Chairman, Vice Chairman and Treasurer elected on a rotational basis are determined taking into account that they are not involved in the operation of secretariat and combine these functions with their main activities



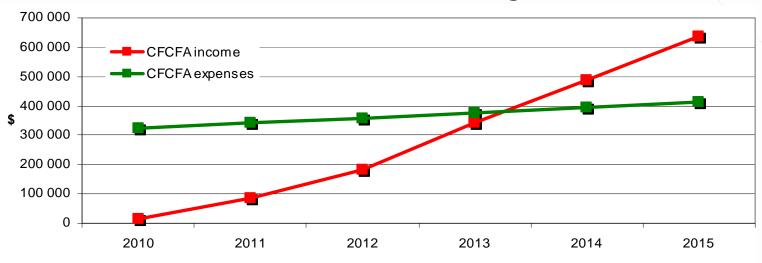

POSSIBLE SOURCES OF CFCFA INCOME,\$:

1. ADB financing



After the funds from the other sources become available, ADB financing will go down. In 3-4 years CFCFA will reach breakeven (see the chart). CFCFA activity will be coordinated with ADB as before. ADB financing will be focused on:

- support of new associations,
- involvement of experts for solution of CFCFA tasks and conduct of trainings,
- transport and trade development projects initiated by CFCFA,
- support of expansion of CFCFA activity, unplanned activities



POSSIBLE SOURCES OF CFCFA INCOME, \$:

2. CFCFA membership fees

- for the fist year 500 US dollars, which later will increase. The amount of fee shall be determined in accordance with CFCFA Constitution during the annual meeting
- the amount of annual fee for each association shall be calculated according to the type of association's activity, quantity of its members and other criteria (algorithm is to be worked out), but it can not be lower than established minimum fee
- minimum annual fee shall be paid by the newly established association during 3 years of its operation maximum. It can be paid also by ADB at the discretion of ADB.
- from the moment of CFCFA breakeven, the entry fee can be implemented



POSSIBLE SOURCES OF CFCFA INCOME, \$:

3. CFCFA trainings*

- will be arranged by secretariat on the basis of training centers of associations of CAREC countries with the involvement of international experts and trainers whose work will be paid by ADB
- Income from trainings shall be divided proportionally between participating association and CFCFA

4-5. CFCFA website*

If "promoted", it can become a considerable source of CFCFA income, as it:

- provides trading floor, possibility of search of back load (customers) for transport facilities;
- provides information support for organization of transportation, is a platform for cooperation.

Income will be gained from:

- subscriber's payment for use of information on back load (customers);
- use of advertising resources (banners, links);
- use of personal page for bidding etc.
- **6.** CFCFA income can be received from the implementation of **solidary (joint) insurance system**.
- **7. CFCFA income can also be gained from the other sources:** organization of participation in various CFCFA actions, purchase of securities, assistance in participation in public private investment projects, etc.

Receipt of income is possible in 3-5 years, it will be needed to determine principles of income use
